Day 1(24/3/2023)

On that auspicious day, 68 Volunteers along with 4 faculties reached the Camp Venue (48km from the University). NSS team went throughout the village, introduced their presence and invited all the natives to make use of our camp activities.

Inauguration of this special camp was headed by **Dr. S.K. ASHOK KUMAR**, University librarian and Campus Director, The Tamil Nadu Dr Ambedkar Law University and **DR. S. MANJULA**, NSS Program officer and Director of placement cell, The Tamil Nadu Dr Ambedkar Law University in the presence of NSS Faculty co-ordinators **Dr. A. MARTINA** and **Dr. S. THIRUMAL**. The dignitary inaugurated the session and threw lights on Importance of rendering service to the society. With his Energetic Words, the thoughts of the volunteers are changed and enlightened.





Day 2 (25/03/2023)

The day started with organic farming. All the volunteers of the NSS team assembled by 6 AM in the morning. Initially the land surface was leveled up by the students with proper equipment and all the non-bio degradable wastes in the land are removed. Then they with proper care and guidance, added manure to the coconut crops.

LEGAL AID AWARENESS RALLY

NSS volunteers along with faculty coordinators arranged for legal aid awareness rally. The main motto of this rally is to educate the villagers and workers of Sevalaya foundation about the free legal aid that is provided under ARTICLE 39A of Indian Constitution.

This legal aid awareness rally was headed by Mr. BALASUBRAMANIAN, District Judge(Retd), Chennai and Mr. Bramanandhasivam, Advocate, Madras High Court and Dr. K. Pushpam, Asst. Professor, TNDALU. NSS volunteers voiced out legal aid slogans and displayed Placards depicting the importance of legal aid during the rally.





Following the rally, the special guests conducted the 'Legal Aid Camp' in which villagers and women workers of the Sevalaya Foundation eagerly attended and clarified all their doubts and queries with regard to their legal issues.

RANGOLI COMPETITION

In the evening, NSS volunteers arranged for a Rangoli competition and invited the villagers and workers of Sevalaya foundation to take part in the competition. Inmates old age home at Sevalaya Foundation also took part in competition by depicting their arts in paper. Finally out of 50 participants, Judges adjudged the winners.



In the evening ceremony, **Mr. BALASUBRAMANIAN**, District Judge (Retd), Chennai with his sparkling words educated the Volunteers of the NSS about the importance of legal aid and lack of awareness about the same. He insisted that every law student must be aware and educate about the legal aid to the maximum extent possible. **Mr. Loganatham**, Advocate, Madras High court also threw lights on the importance of legal aid.



In the ceremony, the winners of the Rangoli competition are given away with prizes and the inmates of old age home who eagerly took part in competition are also provided with special prizes. The ceremony ended with the SOEL NSS team's cultural events.

DAY 3 (26/03/2023)

Day 3 started happily with positive energy. Volunteers assembled by 6 AM in the morning and started performing organic farming. Volunteers continued the work of applying natural fertilizer to every Coconut Crop. On completion of the work, nearly 50 coconut crops are nourished with natural fertilizer and land surface was leveled up properly and removed all the non bio degradable waste.



On this day, SOEL NSS Volunteers arranged for Drawing, speech and Essay writing competition among the students of MAHAKAVI BHARATHIYAAR MATRICULATION SCHOOL, KASUVA. 100 students of the school who were permanently residing in Sevalaya foundation campus under the category of Orphan, Destitute, Below poverty Line are invited for this competition.

Speech Competition in the theme of **My Dream, My ambition** and Essay writing competition in the theme of **My favourite leader, My favourite Teacher** and Drawing competition was conducted for the students and best out of each event are selected as winners.



This was followed by conducting fun events for old age home residents. All the old age home residents actively and with enthusiasm participated in the games. NSS volunteers organised many game activities and cheered them.



Following that, In the evening a special session was conducted by **Mr. Yoga acharya Prabhakaran**, Yoga expert. In the health benefit session, the speaker emphasized the importance of Yoga in human life and also educated the audience about the health hazards that arise now a days. He also taught the audience some breathing exercises and also added few tips for healthy flow of life. The ceremony ended with our SOEL NSS team's cultural events.



DAY 4 (27/03/2023)

Day 4 began with organic farming and natural fertilizer was added to each and every coconut crop and at end of 3 days work, NSS team successfully leveled up the area, cleaned all wastes and nourished 100 coconut crops in total with natural fertilizer and manure. Volunteers were interested in doing all such tasks and they were proficient enough in handling all sort of agricultural equipment.



CLEANING CAMP

The task of the day was to clean up the School and Temple Campus around Kasuva village. NSS team of 68 students along with Faculty Coordinator prepared themselves for cleaning activities. All were provided with hand gloves and garbage bags and divided themselves into teams. Each team took control over that area with proper intervals. All the 12 Teams coordinated well among themselves and collected each and every **plastic wastes like wrappers, cups, bottles, polythene bags etc.**

The cleaning process was entirely carried over around the campus of Sevalaya foundation and around the Temple. In the end, our team collected **50 kgs** of plastic and non-bio degradable wastes and they

were all properly disposed by the volunteers. The great success of this cleaning camp was that the villagers also supported us. On seeing our camp, the **villagers promised that they will reduce the usage of such plastics in their life.**



Following that, in the evening the NSS team conducted **debate session** on the topic “The happiness of the family depends on “Male”?? Or “Female”??. This debate session was headed by **Mr. M.T. Anandham**, Asst. Professor, Chennai Dr. Ambedkar Law College, Pudhupakkam. He delivered his wonderful words over family bonding and indispensable role played by both male and female in family. Both the teams sparked up the events with valuable points and counter attacks. Their words were both entertaining as well as meaningful and it taught the audience about the struggles faced by both male and female in running a family successfully. The ceremony ended up with our SOEL NSS team’s cultural events.



Day 5 (28/03/2023)

Day 5 with no drop in the energy level, the team assembled early in the morning. Volunteers carried out their organic farming work, the next task assigned was to plough the waste land and make it suitable for cultivation. It was an area of around 3500 sqft land filled with weeds and wastes and stagnant water. NSS team volunteers with proper equipment, removed all the weeds in the land and

drained out all the stagnant water. Around 30% of the task was completed by the volunteers on that day



CONSUMER AWARENESS RALLY

The task of that day was to conduct a consumer awareness rally and make the natives of the village aware of their rights and duties as a consumer. The goal set by the team in this rally was to make every people of the village including children to be aware of their consumer rights.

NSS VOLUNTEERS were organised by **Mrs. Kalaimagal** and **Ms. Divya, Guest lecturer, TNDALU**. Volunteers prepared placards depicting the consumer protection legislation, quotes and slogans and conducted a rally. In that rally team voiced out catchy slogans and drew all the people attention. Some volunteers randomly met people in person and gave them awareness as a consumer while buying a product or availing a service.



Following that, in the evening **special session** was taken over by **Mrs. J. Vijayathilagam**, Asst. Commissioner (Retd.), Civil supplies and Consumer protection Department, Government of Tamil Nadu. The session was useful and was completely filled with all sorts of legal information which was required to our law students as well as ordinary citizens of our country. This session threw lights on various aspects of consumer awareness and protection. It was an interactive session where the speaker clarified all doubts of audience and made everyone to realize their rights and duties as consumer. The ceremony ended with our SOEL NSS team's cultural events.



Day 6 (29/03/2023)

This day began at 6AM in the morning and all the volunteers were divided into 2 teams. One team carried out the duty of ploughing the land to make it suitable for cultivation. Team was provided with machines, tools and equipment , they ploughed the land and removed all the hard rocks, plastic wastes, weeds in the land.

The other team prepared the land for sapling plantation. Volunteers divided among themselves and took over their tasks. Each group coordinated among themselves and dig holes for sapling plantation, removed unwanted crops in the plantation area, leveled up the land surface and made arrangements for regular water supply to such saplings.



AWARENESS ON VOTING RIGHTS

NSS Team along with LLM. Students (**CONSTITUTIONAL LAW AND HUMAN RIGHTS**) of The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University joined hands and conducted awareness camp on Voting rights of the people. This team conducted field study about the natives' culture and awareness level. They went to each house in the village and questioned their awareness with regard to voting rights followed by that they also provided them with awareness about the importance of voting and legal duties. The team also educated the villagers to achieve a **corruption free election in India**.
