MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Government Law
University College/ established by the Government of Tamil Nadu
by an Act of the State Legislature (Act No. 43 of 1997)

And

Swapna Sundar

The Parties

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, hereinafter 'The University', was established by the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University Act, 1996 (Act No.43 of 1997), having the objects, inter alia, under Section 4 to develop in the student and research scholar, a sense of responsibility to serve the society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy, legal services, legislation, law reforms and the like; to promote acquisition of legal knowledge in rapidly developing and changing society and to continually offer opportunities for upgrading knowledge, training and skills in the context of innovation, research and discovery in all fields of human endeavours. The University is housed at "Poompozhil", #5, Dr.D.G.S.Dinakaran Salai, Chennai – 600 028 AND

Ms. Swapna Sundar, having office at No.7/8 Flowers Road, III Lane, Purusaiwalkam, Chennai 600084 holds a post-graduate in law, is a patent agent and IP Strategist, and has experience and expertise in process management, process design and process development towards ease and efficiency of administration, and stake-holder satisfaction. She is also the CEO of IP Dome Strategy Advisors Pvt. Ltd., Chennai.

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, herein after 'The University' and Ms. Swapna Sundar. The University and Swapna Sundar are referred to **collectively**, as "Parties" or individually as "party".

1. Purpose

The University has entered into an MOU with the Commissioner of Municipal Administration, Government of Tamil Nadu to undertake a study of the prevalent trade licensing norms and procedures, with the aim of creating a licensing system that is uniform, responsive and efficient, and would facilitate ease of compliance. The University agreed to undertake a study of the extant provisions for providing trade licenses by the CMA through the urban local bodies (ULBs) in

Tamil Nadu, other than Chennai. The study will be undertaken by the Principal Investigator named below, under the overall guidance of the Vice Chancellor of the University. Masters level students of the University shall be recruited as Interns to assist in the study.

Consequent to Notification No. 2107 issued by the University, the University hereby designates, Ms. Swapna Sundar, the Second Party herein, as the Principal Investigator, who shall undertake the study and monitor the project. She shall be responsible for maintaining the timelines proposed and providing the deliverables as provided in the 'Scope of Work' set out in Annexure -1 hereto. The University also deposes faculty member, Prof. Ranjit Abraham as a Coordinator for the study.

2. Scope

The scope of the study shall be to undertake a comprehensive study of the trade licensing regime in the municipalities and corporations, other than the Chennai City Municipal Corporation, (together termed as Urban Local Bodies, hereinafter ULBs) under the control and administration of the CMA, as detailed in the 'Scope of Work' set out in Annexure 1 hereto. This shall be done by studying the relevant laws, subordinate legislations, regulations and guidelines established for the purpose in the ULBs and more particularly to:

2.1 Study:

- 2.11 the extant procedure for grant and renewal of trade licenses
- 2.12 the extant cost for the grant and renewal of trade licences in the ULBs
- 2.13 the extant conditions for the grant and renewal of trade licences in the ULBs

2.2 Analyse:

- 2.21 the barriers to compliance with the process of grant and renewal of trade licenses
- 2.22 the difficulties in monitoring and administration of the process for grant and renewal of trade licences
- 2.23 the variance in conditions and procedures for granting and renewal of trade licenses in the ULBs

2.3 Recommend:

- 2.31 inclusion of certain trades in the licensing regime, which have not been formerly included in the list
- 2.32 changes in the extant provisions to improve compliance, in particular through
 - 2.321 change of terminology from 'Dangerous and Offensive Trade Licensing' to other appropriate terminology
 - 2.322 simplifying procedures in the grant, renewal, administration and monitoring of trade licenses using ICT where feasible
 - 2.323 common procedures and conditions for all the ULBs to increase transparency, compliance and ease of grant, renewal, administration and monitoring of trade licenses
 - 2.324 creating a decision hierarchy that can reduce issues in managing the administration and monitoring of grant, renewal, administration and monitoring of trade licenses

3 Costs

The CMA has undertaken to bear the cost of the study under the MOU with the University cited in Clause 1 above. The total cost of the project shall be INR 2021610 (Inclusive of taxes) The CMA has agreed to pay the said sum to the University in the following manner:

Signing of MOU	50% of total project sum being INR 10,10,805
Preparation and presentation of Draft Report (16 weeks from signing of MOU)	25% of total project sum being INR 5,05,402
Preparation and presentation of Final Report (22 weeks from signing of MOU)	25% of total project sum being INR 5,05,402

The University shall retain 20% of the same as Institutional cost, from which sum, the University shall pay a suitable remuneration to the student interns, and shall pay the remaining sum to the Principal Investigator towards the cost of undertaking the study immediately, (within one week) upon receipt of each phase of the payment.

4 Role of the University

- 4.1 The University shall designate one of its faculty members as faculty supervisor who shall be responsible for supervising the project
- 4.2 The University and its functionaries shall support and afford all cooperation to the Principal Investigator, Ms. Swapna Sundar in respect of the proposed study until its completion.
- 4.3 The University shall depute student interns of the Masters level at suitable remuneration to be paid by the University to the study in consultation with the Principal Investigator.

4.4 The University shall provide space and library access to the student interns and the Principal Investigator for conducting the required research, as may be requested by the Principal Investigator.

5 Role of the CMA

5.1 The CMA shall provide all support to the University and the Principal Investigator to undertake the study until completion of the said study.

5.2 The CMA shall provide documents, manuals, guidelines, copies of legislations, subordinate legislations, rules, and regulations to conduct the study

5.3 The CMA shall depute one officer to assist the Principal Investigator, provide her/him with all relevant information required and cooperate fully in the study until its completion.

5.4 The CMA shall ensure that all payments are made immediately (within one week) upon completion of each milestone in terms of the Schedule of Payment set out in the Annexure hereto.

6 Role of the Principal Investigator

6.1 The Principal Investigator shall be responsible for preparation of the proposal, project design and project management.

6.2 She shall be responsible for maintaining the timelines as agreed to in the MOU, and shall be responsible for outcomes and deliverables.

6.3 She shall execute the project as outlined in the proposal using sound management techniques.

6.4 She shall maintain an accurate record of project related expenses, and comply with the terms and conditions of the project award. She shall carry out the project's financial plan as presented in the proposal, or make changes to the plan following a prescribed set of procedures.

6.5 She shall report project progress to the Registrar and Coordinator of the University and the CMA as outlined in the proposal.

7 General Provisions

Disputes shall be settled at the first instance through mediation. If the process fails, the dispute shall be referred to an Arbitrator to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties hereto and also the Principal Investigator. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall apply to the proceedings. The venue shall be Chennai.

The agreement shall be governed by the laws of India as applicable to the State of Tamil Nadu. Courts in Chennai shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes arising hereunder.

None of the confidential documents, papers, files, file notations, records and other information made available to the University or the Principal Investigator by the CMA or to either of the Parties hereto to the other shall be disclosed by the receiving party to any third party without express, prior written approval of the disclosing party.

Provided that Confidential Information does not include information:

- a) that is in the public domain;
- b) that was in the receiving party's lawful possession at the time of disclosure;
- c) that the receiving party lawfully received from a third party.

The intellectual property in the study report shall belong to the CMA.


All and any processes undertaken by the Principal Investigator and the tools, if any developed by her and disclosed to the University, its personnel or Interns shall be treated as confidential and remain the property of the Principal Investigator.


The provisions herein represent the entire Agreement between the Parties, and any amendment or modification of the same shall be in writing.

9. Duration

The duration of this MOU shall be 6 months starting May 1, 2013, or until the completion of the study and submission of the completed report to the CMA, whichever is later. The parties may renew the MOU by mutual agreement in respect of other studies or projects if deemed necessary.

- [2] Based on the selection order issued by the UGC on the recommendations of the UGC Expert Committee and on the request made by the individual, Permission is hereby granted to Dr. V. Balaji, Associate Professor, Department of International Law & Organisation, School of Excellence in Law, the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, Chennai, to undergo the UGC Research Award for a period of two (2) years with effect from 1st March, 2015, without undertaking any Research guidance.
- [3] The Research period of 2 years i.e. w.e.f. 01.03.2015, in respect of Dr.V. Balaji, Associate Professor is treated as 'Duty Leave' and he will be continued to earn normal increment and maintain his seniority in this University.
- [4] In order to remain in touch with the latest developments in his respective areas of teaching in the concerned subject and research, Dr. V. Balaji, Associate Professor is required to take classes in this University, if necessary, without any additional remuneration. This Period of teaching is inclusive of the full tenure of the Award.
- [5] Dr. V. Balaji, Associate Professor, is hereby permitted to undergo the UGC Research Award for a period of two (2) years with effect from the 1st March, 2015 with the terms and conditions governed by the UGC, as mentioned below:

- During the period of award, Dr. V. Balaji, Associate Professor will be paid full salary with admissible allowances which would be reimbursed to this University except the CPF contribution, as the same is to be borne by this University.
 - Research grant to meet expenditure on books and journals, chemicals and equipments for the entire period is as under:
 - Humanities and Social Sciences including languages: Rs.2.00 Lakh
 - Sciences/Natural Sciences/Engineering and Technology: Rs.3.00 Lakh
 - The awardee, being on duty leave, shall continue to earn normal increment and maintain his seniority in this university.
 - He will be entitled to holidays and all other privileges as per his entitlement in the university, including facilities of staff quarters/medical assistance, etc. during the period of the award.
 - Expenditure towards travel within the country in connection with research work has to be met out of the research grant only. No additional funds will be provided for this purpose.
 - The expenditure towards engagement of any project assistant will have to be met out of research grant for a maximum amount of Rs.5000/-p.m. (consolidated) during the tenure of the award only. The tenure of the project assistant will be co-terminus with the Research Award.
 - The commission will not provide any grant awards the salary of the substitute, if appointed, in place of the awardee.
- [6] Dr. V. Balaji, shall submit a mid-term progress report of the Research work through the Head of Department as well as the Registrar of the University on completion of 12 months from the date of joining.
- [7] On completion of the award, two copies of the final report of the project should be submitted by the awardee through the Head of the Department as well as Head of the University/College to the UGC along with an abstract, clearance (No dues), consolidated details of expenditure and audited Utilization Certificate against the full grants sanctioned during his tenure.
- [8] In the consolidated report, the fellow must outline the objectives set forth and objectives achieved, along with possible application of the research output and names of user agency/organisation and Industry that can take advantage of the research.
- [9] The terms and conditions as may be amended by the Commission from time to time shall be abided by the awardee.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION GOVERNMENT OF INDIA AND THE TAMIL NADU DR. AMBEDKAR LAW UNIVERSITY, CHENNAI IN RESPECT OF THE CHAIR OF EXCELLENCE ON CONSUMER LAW & JURISPRUDENCE.

This MoU is made and entered into on this ^{5th August 2011} ~~5th August 2011~~ at New Delhi, between, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, (Food & Public Distribution), Department of Consumer Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, through its Joint Secretary, (hereinafter called as the "First Party/DCA" which term shall unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include their successors, assignees and administrators) ON THE FIRST PART.

AND

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University located at Chennai through its Vice Chancellor (hereinafter called as the "Second Party", which term shall unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include their successors, assignees, and administrators) ON THE SECOND PART.

And WHEREAS, the First Party/DCA has been approached by the Second Party/Grantee that the Second Party is having some consumer welfare project with the specific aims and objects. Therefore, after considering the aim and objectives of the consumer welfare project, the First Party has agreed that a project in this regard need to be supported by First Party and whereas the SECOND PARTY had submitted a proposal for establishing Chair/Centre on Civil liberties and Consumer Protection which has been approved by the Standing Committee set up under (CWF) Consumer Welfare Fund Rules 1992 (hereinafter called as CWF Rules) for financing the project from the said fund which has been approved for the said project vide CWF's letter No.O-11011/89/2010-CWF dated 11.7.2011.

On the basis of proposal from the Second party, the First party/DCA has approved and sanctioned the proposal for financial assistance for establishing a Chair of Excellence on Consumer Law and Jurisprudence at an estimated cost of Rs 94.45 lakh spread over a period of 5 years commencing from date of release of funds as per the approval letter No. O-11011/89/2010-CWF dated 11.7.2011 issued by CWF and as per terms and given in the sanction letter No O-11011/89/2010-CWF dated 11.7.2011 issued by the First Party

The primary objectives of the Project are:

- (i) To provide for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge of law and their role in the development of better education.
- (ii) To promote legal education and well being of the community generally;
- (iii) To develop in the student and research scholar a sense of responsibility to serve the society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy legal services, legislation, law reforms and the like;
- (iv) To organize lectures, seminars, symposia and conferences;
- (v) To provide access to legal education of large segments of the population and in particular to the disadvantaged groups;
- (vi) To promote acquisition of legal knowledge in rapidly developing and changing society and to continually offers opportunities for upgrading knowledge, training and skills in the context of innovation, research and discovery in all field of human endeavors.
- (vii) To start a regular PG Diploma on Consumer Protection and promote research in Consumer Law & Jurisprudence.
- (viii) to promote national integration and the integrated development of the human personality through its policies and programmes.

AND WHEREAS, the First party/DCA has agreed to sanction a grant of Rs 85.01 lakh as cost to carry on the activities under the Project, (hereinafter referred to as the "Grant") subject to the condition and satisfaction of First Party/DCA that the Grant will be used for the desired purpose and the Second Party agrees to abide by the terms and conditions set out in the said sanction letter O-11011/89/2010-CWF dated 11.7.2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PROMISES AND MUTUAL COVENANTS HEREINAFTER CONTAINED, BOTH THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS.

I. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT AND CLARIFICATION

This Agreement details the responsibilities and obligations of First Party/DCA, and Second Party

II. RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF FIRST PARTY/DCA

- a) The First Party will provide financial support to the Second Party of a sum of Rs 85.01 lakh (hereinafter referred to as the "Grant") out of the total cost of the project of Rs.94.45 lakh and the remaining Rs.9.44 lakh will be contributed by the Second party itself as its own contribution for a period of 5 years (hereinafter referred to as the "Period") towards implementation of the various programmes and activities under the project on the condition that the Second Party agrees to abide by the terms and conditions set out in the said sanction letter O-11011/39/2010-CWF dated 11.7.2011.
- b) An amount of Rs.34.01 lakh as first installment of grant shall be payable within one month from the date of execution of this MoU. The remaining grant for the second and third installment will be released on submission of Utilization certificate (UC) and on the recommendation of the Executive Committee.
- c) The FIRST PARTY/DCA neither will be responsible nor liable for any claims or liabilities of any nature whatsoever, including those arising from employment of contractual manpower employed by Second Party of any status and nature, if any to be arised, or arising out of or in the course of employment of any employee.
- d) The First party/DCA shall introduce a system of concurrent evaluation for regular feedback regarding the functioning of the sanctioned project. The second part will not raise any objection or obstacle of any kind what so ever.
- e) The First Party/DCA will periodically monitor the progress of activities under the project through an Executive committee, set up for the purpose. The committee will meet at least once every six months and recommend release of subsequent installment of grants.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF SECOND PARTY

1. The Second Party will submit proposal for release of second fund instalment of funds and the release of funds will be on the basis of the UC and statement of Expenditure and on recommendation of the Executive Committee, the record of which is to be maintained properly by Second Party.

2. The Second Party shall keep the First party/DCA informed of the progress made in the project on a quarterly basis.

3. The Second Party agrees to achieve the following objectives through this project: (i) To provide for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge of law and their role in the development of better education

(ii) To promote legal education and well being of the community generally;

(iii) To develop in the student and research scholar a sense of responsibility to serve the society in the field of law by developing skills in regard to advocacy legal services, legislation, law reforms and the like;

(iv) To organize lectures, seminars, symposia and conferences;

(v) To provide access to legal education of large segments of the population and in particular to the disadvantaged groups;

(vi) To promote acquisition of legal knowledge in rapidly developing and changing society and to continually offers opportunities for upgrading knowledge, training and skills in the context of innovation, research and discovery in all field of human endeavours.

(vii). To start a regular PG Diploma course on Consumer Protection and promote research in Consumer Law & Jurisprudence.

(viii) to promote national integration and the integrated development of the human personality through its policies and programmes.

4. The Second Party shall ensure that the assets acquired out of the grant from the Consumer Welfare Fund are suitably maintained and insured.

5. SECOND PARTY, wherever applicable, agrees to maintain an Assets Register and other documents record showing all the assets whenever acquired out of the grants mentioned above and agree to undertake disposal of these through appropriate procedure as per General Financial Rules (GFR) and credit the receipts there of to the First Party/DCA

6. The Second Party hereby agrees that the assets acquired by it from the grants released from time to time will revert back to the First Party/DCA in the event of the project failing at any point of time for any reason whatsoever.

7. The Second Party agrees that in case any deviations or modifications are necessary to carry out the project, those deviations or modification will be carried out, only after the due written approval of the Executive Committee, set up by the First Party/DCA for this purpose.

8. The second party agrees that,

- It shall operate a separate Bank Account for this project.
- It shall maintain proper accounts of the actual expenditure incurred under various Heads as also the revenue realized from time to time and make necessary arrangements for audit of such accounts through Auditors empanelled by the Comptroller, and Auditor General (CAG) or Company Law Board.(CLB)
- It shall submit duly audited statement of accounts for expenditure up to 75% of the grant released earlier by the First Party for said project, before claiming the next installment due for the project.
- It shall make available all related documents, transactions and vouchers to the internal audit team appointed by the First Party/DCA as and when felt necessary for internal evaluation by First Party/DCA.
- It shall credit back to the First Party/DCA any receipts out of the proceeds of the sale or auction of assets acquired out of the grant given by First Party for the project but this amount may be utilized to earn more money for the project only. However no such transaction may be done by the Second Party without informing the First Party in writing.

9.) The Second Party agrees that First Party/DCA shall not be liable for any disputes legal or otherwise that may arise out of any action on the part of the Second Party. The loss, if any, to be incurred in such activities to be borne by the Second Party exclusively.

10.) (a) SECOND PARTY will provide the "infrastructure", including the space, office equipments including computers and information related facilities and services, etc. for all the activities under the Project.

(b) SECOND PARTY will submit to the First Party/DCA a quarterly report of activities and a detailed performance-cum-activities report at the end of the every year.

(c) SECOND PARTY, while seeking release of Grants, will submit, to the First Party/DCA all reasonable evidences of proper utilization of instalments released earlier by the First Party for the said project.

(d) SECOND PARTY, will follow and comply with all conditions attached to the grant-in-aid for the project as per GFR.

(e) SECOND PARTY, shall indemnify the FIRST PARTY/DCA against any claim, which may be made under the Workmen's Compensation Act 1926, or any statutory modifications thereof or otherwise, in respect of any damages or compensation payable in consequence of any accident or injury sustained by any workmen or other person while in the employment of the SECOND PARTY or its contractor/agents so long as such accident or injury arose within the preview of the project envisaged in this Agreement.

(f) SECOND PARTY shall further indemnify the FIRST PARTY/DCA against any damage, caused, expenses and/ or claim occasioned by any infringement of Patents or Intellectual Patents or Intellectual Property Rights, arising out of any acts or omissions by or on behalf of SECOND PARTY.

IV. TIMELINES FOR ACTIVITIES / TARGETS

1.	Infrastructure & staff etc.:	Within three months

3.	Performance cum Activity Report	At the end of each financial year.

6.	Development of PG Curriculum.	One year
7.	Seminar/Workshop	Minimum one per year as per decision of the Executive Committee.
8.	Evaluation	End of 2 nd and 5 th year.

7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following broad terms and conditions are mutually agreed upon by both the parties hereto.

- 1) It is agreed that the First Party/DCA reserves the rights to cancel the project at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever. It is also agreed that the First Party/DCA would not incur any liability whatsoever if the project is terminated before completion of its full term.
2. (a) It is agreed by the Second Party that all assets including Physical and intellectual property and patents created out of the Grant released by the First Party for the project of Second Party would be the property of the First Party/DCA and the First Party/DCA can make them freely utilize itself or can make available and accessible to anyone at its instance. (b) The Second Party shall extend all the requisite support to the First Party/DCA in fulfilling the procedural formalities to acquire the legal rights thereon.
3. The Second Party also agrees that the First Party/DCA will not liable for any disputes legal or otherwise that may arise out of the actions of the Second Party with any Third Party (Whomsoever).
4. FIRST PARTY/DCA will provide support for a period of 5 years from the date of this MoU.
5. An Executive Committee shall be constituted to monitor the implementation of this MoU which will be comprised as under:

6. The Executive Committee will review the overall performance under this MoU and shall meet at least once in six months for evaluation of the specific activities undertaken under the Project.

7. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither of the parties shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MoU due to the exigency of one or more of the force Majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquakes, Strikes not confined to the premises of the party, Lockouts beyond the control of the party, claiming force Majeure, Epidemics, Riots, civil commotions etc. provided on the occurrence of and cessation of any such event within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the Force Majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action of the project.

8. In case of any disputes or differences arising out of this MoU or in the operations of the project, during the validity period of this MoU the same shall be resolved through mutual discussions between both parties. Any unresolved disputes or differences shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator who will be a Retired Judge of a High Court or the Supreme Court to be appointed by FIRST PARTY/DCA, whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi and the arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any modification or reenactment thereof.

The High Court of Delhi and the Courts subordinate to it at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters concerning this MoU including any matters concerning this MoU including any matter arising out of the arbitration proceedings or any Award made therein.

9. This is the sole MoU between the Parties hereto, for the purpose mentioned herein and any other communication made on this subject contrary to the covenants contained herein shall not be applicable and will not have any effect and also will not be entertained by the First Party.

VI. DURATION OF THIS MoU:

- i. This MoU will be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of signing it, unless the project sanctioned to the second party is terminated before expiry of the sanctioned period and the period can be extended in writing only and by mutual consent of both

the parties.

ii. It is agreed that the FIRST PARTY/DCA reserves the right to cancel the Grant to the Second Party before the end of the period of MoU, if the Second Party fails to comply with the terms and conditions of this MoU.

iii. It is also agreed that the FIRST PARTY/DCA would not incur any liability whatsoever, if the funding of the Project is terminated before completion of period and project.

The Survey on Consumer Awareness about Health and Drugs was conducted in 2017-2018. Eighty student volunteers, ten each from eight affiliated law colleges of the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University were deployed to undertake the survey under the supervision of the Project Co-ordinator. A total of 3200 persons were interviewed by the students. Of the 3200 persons interviewed, 1728 were male and 1462 were female. 1255 persons of those interviewed, live in rural areas and the remaining 1945 in urban areas. Random sampling method was followed while conducting the survey. The survey was confined to people, response to the allopathic system of medicine only.

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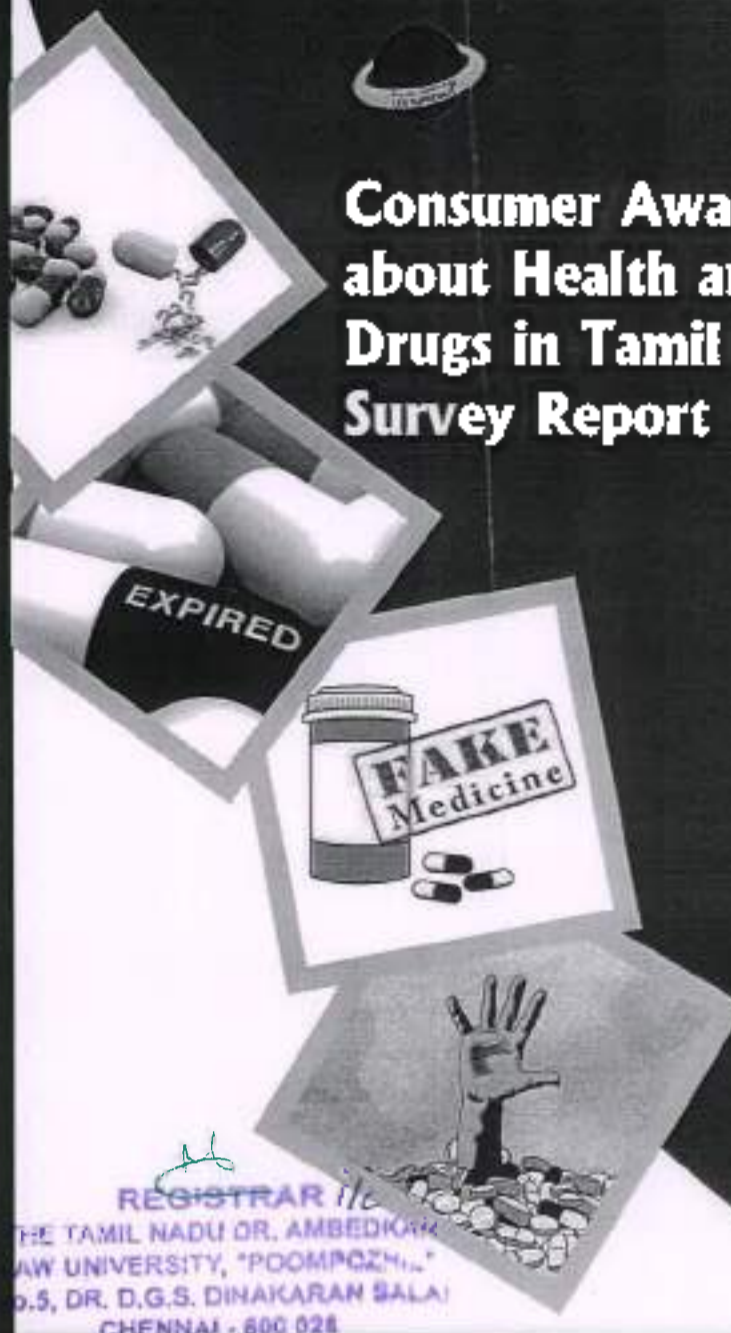



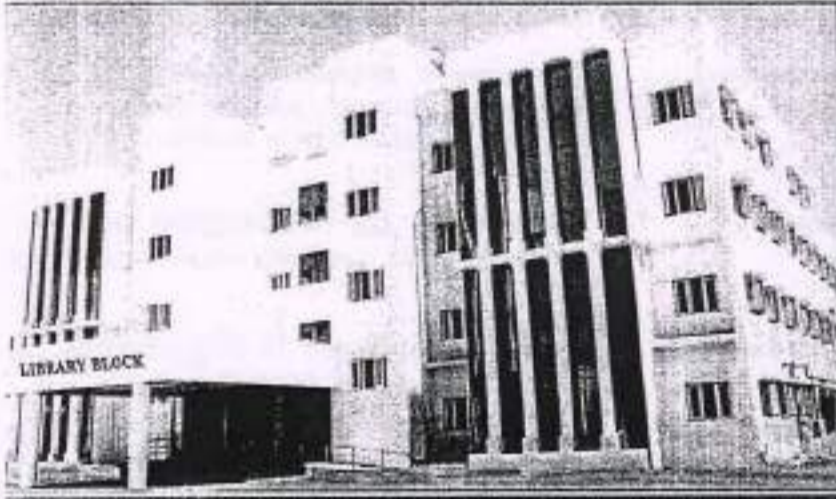

The Consumer Protection Amendment Bill, 2018 had incorporated a proposal to regulate the security issues prevailing over smart products. The definitions included in the Bill such as 'e-commerce' and bringing the scope of online purchasers within the definition of the term 'Consumers' were welcomed by all stakeholders. Unfortunately, the Bill has since lapsed and it is not clear how long it will take for the amendments to become a reality. Till the law is amended, the issues mentioned above will have to be faced by the consumers.

In this background, The Chair of Excellence on Consumer Law and Jurisprudence (CECLJ) of the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University, Chennai is organizing a One Day Workshop on 'Trusted Smart Products and Challenges faced by Consumers' on 14th March, 2019, on the eve of World Consumer Rights Day, to discuss the key issues raised above.

Academics, advocates, officials from the concerned Government Departments, consumer related NGO's, research scholars, and students are invited to attend the workshop and share their views on securing consumers' trust in smart products.



Preamble

Sigrum Schindler invented a method to assess the situation of facts (Tatsachenlage) in the environment of patent application and patent litigation proceedings in a by far more structured manner than usual so far. This method is supported by the software tool "FSTP" developed in cooperation with the Freie Universität Berlin, Germany.

This method and the tool bring up interesting scientific questions like e.g. regarding its learnability, the mistakes made during its usage in comparison to mistakes made so far, regarding the reduction of the effort concerning the fact assessment etc.

The University shall test this software tool and run pilot studies.

Prof. Ranjit C. Oommen shall act as the Project Leader and consultant to conceptualize, direct, manage, and supervise other research assistants or students ("Research Associates") to

perform an analysis of the technology involved in the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals cases for potential use in developing the FSTP method and software and the Facts Screening/Transforming Processor (FSTP) provisional patent application (such analysis hereinafter referred to as the "Project").

§ 1 Tasks and Rules of Cooperation

- 1.1 The Project shall be carried out during a period of approximately twenty four (24) months, starting 1st October 2010.
- 1.2 The University shall perform an analysis of the technology involved in up to cases of the Supreme Court of India and the Court of Appeals that contain holdings regarding the obviousness of claims that were at issue, for potential use in regard to the FSTP method and software and the Facts Screening/ Transforming Processor (FSTP) provisional patent application.
- 1.3 The Project Leader shall provide the following services:
 - 1.3.1 select doctorates and/or able students to act as Research Associates in the Project.
 - 1.3.2 conceptualize, coordinate, direct, manage, and supervise Research Associates.
 - 1.3.3 attend occasional status meetings in Bangalore or Berlin, Germany (or other locations as requested by Principal), or otherwise to provide periodic progress updates as requested by Principal.
- 1.4 The team of Research Associates shall consist of research scholars striving for their doctorate and patent lawyer, as appropriate and to be determined by Project Leader.
- 1.5 The University shall present to Principal the actual development status every three months at the latest and shall for the following development period be geared to the guidelines and priorities given by the Principal at that time.
- 1.6 The Principal shall answer all inquiries of the University regarding intentions and functions of the FSTP method short-term.
- 1.7 The University assigns to the Principal free of charge the exclusive, unlimited, worldwide, irrevocable right to use the work results for all known and unknown types of use – specifically, but not limited to – use, use in parts, modify, incorporate, distribute, publish, license, exhibit, record, digitize, broadcast, reproduce and archive, in any format or medium, whether now known or hereafter developed.
- 1.8 The Principal grants the University free of charge a non-exclusive, non-transferable, timely unlimited licence to use these work results solely for internal non-paid scientific purposes, for which also data of external third parties may be used. In particular the University is allowed to use the FSTP tool also together with real users for actual patent cases during the term of this contract and one year thereafter.

to the University, in cases of a violation of contractual secondary obligations the liability shall be limited to the amount of three times the compensation in total. Liability for production downtimes/service interruptions, loss of profit and other consequential damages is excluded, except in cases of wilful intent. Claims due to impairment of performance shall prescribe after six months from the knowledge of the Principal, as far as the impairment of performance was not done with wilful intent.

6.3 As far as the liability of the University is excluded or limited, this shall apply also for the Project Leader, the Research Associates and other employees, officers, representatives and auxiliary persons of the University

6.4 The Principal shall not be liable for any acts or omissions of the University

§ 7 Termination, Survival

7.1 Either Party has the right to terminate this Agreement, or to terminate the work of the Project at any time for any reason not prohibited by law, by providing at least four (4) weeks prior written notice of termination to the other Party's address specified in this Agreement.

7.2 If the Agreement is terminated, Principal will remain obligated to pay to University the appropriate pro rata amount of the quarterly compensation until the date of termination for a) services performed at the time, and b) any expenses incurred before such termination.

7.3 The following Sections of this Agreement shall survive termination: § 4 (Nondisclosure, Freedom of Publication), § 5 (Inventions), § 6 (Liability) and § 9 (Applicable Law and Jurisdiction).

§ 8 Modifications of and Amendments to the Contract

8.1 Any modification of or amendment to this Agreement shall be void, unless made in written form. For the avoidance of doubt: email does not meet the requirement of written form.


8.2 In the event that any term of this Agreement is found invalid, that term shall be severed from the Agreement and all other terms shall remain effective. The parties shall be obligated to replace the invalid or ineffective clause by a valid clause that comes closest to the intended economic meaning and the contractual purpose.



§ 3 Compensation and Expenses

- 3.1 The maximum project volume is 80 000.- EUR (in words: Eighty Thousand Euro), if applicable plus VAT.
- 3.2 As compensation for above research services this amount shall be payable to University – subject to clause 7 – in arrears in up to eight (8) quarterly instalments of appr. 10 000.- € (Ten Thousand Euro) – if applicable plus VAT – upon request by the University, such request specifying the bank account of the University and stating the respective Project reference number.
- 3.3 At least 80% of the compensation shall be used for financing Research Associates in a university common matter (alternatively proportionately for student or scientific assistants or equivalent contracts for work and services). These personnel costs are to be proven to the Principal. The Principal disclaims the proof of the other expenses.
- 3.4 For necessary travel performed by Project Leader pursuant to Section 1.3.3 above, Principal agrees to pay for the full costs of such travel expenses, including airfares, transportation charges, and any other incidental charges reasonably related to such travel. Airfare shall be for economy class rates, and hotels, meals, ground transportation, etc. shall be at reasonable rates and (for airfare and hotels, whenever feasible) shall be approved in advance by Principal before being incurred.
- 3.5 Payment for travel expenses shall be made by Principal within one month of receipt of a detailed invoice containing a statement itemizing such expenses. The Project Leader shall provide billing information for any travel and any information and receipts for any such expenses with a reasonable degree of specificity, and shall provide the original receipts for any expenses incurred.
- 3.6 Travel by Research Associates is not deemed necessary.

§ 4 Nondisclosure, Freedom of Publication

- 4.1 The University undertakes to not disclose to third parties and keep confidential any business secrets of the Principal and/or any privileged or non-public confidential information or facts which the University may acquire during the cooperation, regardless whether such information was marked confidential by the Principal or should be considered as confidential by its nature; in case of doubt confidentiality shall apply. This obligation shall continue after the end of this cooperation.
- 4.2 The University will take all necessary measures to enforce the confidentiality with the Project Leader, the Research Associates and all other persons with access to such information.
- 4.3 The Principal accepts that the University may need to publish research results and shall allow for this. Any such publication shall not disclose trade secrets of Principal or adversely affect any pending or contemplated patent applications relating to the FSTP, or otherwise owned by Principal. The University undertakes to obtain Principal's prior written approval of any intended publication by submitting a draft of such publication (in English or German translation) for review at the latest 30 days before the deadline of submission for publication; the Principal shall not withhold this approval unreasonably.

§ 5 Inventions

- 5.1 Any inventions or improvements regarding the FSTP method or its application or implementation made by University, the Project Leader or any of the Research Associates in the course of performing the Project shall belong to the Principal. The University herewith assigns free of charge all rights arising from and title to such invention or improvement to the Principal. If additional compensation for such transfer of rights is required by applicable law of a mandatory nature which cannot be derogated from by contract, the Principal shall have the option to request or not to request the transfer of the rights concerned.
- 5.2 The Principal shall have the sole right to apply for industrial property rights protection for any such invention or improvement. The University and the Project Leader shall upon request by the Principal use best efforts to support the Principal in an application. The University and the Project Leader further undertake to refrain from any action or omission endangering a successful application for IP protection.

§ 6 Liability

- 6.1 The University shall carry out the agreed tasks with reasonable care, to its best endeavours, with qualified personnel and on the basis of the newest state-of-the-art of science and technology developed and known by the University respectively. Any warranty shall be expressly excluded.
- 6.2 For all contractual or legal claims in connection with this contract, the University shall only be liable in cases of wilful intent or gross negligence. In cases of gross negligence the liability for defaults shall be limited for each case to the amount of the compensation paid
