Tauil Nadu Acts and Ordinanocas

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of this President on the 19th July 1994 [and is hereby [published [for general information :---

ACT No. 45 OF 1994.

An Act to provide for reservation of seats in educational institutions in the State and of appointments or posts in the services under the State for the Backward Classes of citizens and for persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes in the State of Tanul Nadu.

WHEREAS the policy of reservation for the social, economic and educational advancement of the people belonging to Backward Classes of citizens in admissions to oducational institutions in the State and for appointments in the services under the State has been under implementation in the State of Tamil Nadu for a long time;

AND WHEREAS the State of Tamil Madu is a pioneer State in providing reservation for the underprivileged and the first opmmunal Government Order was passed in the year 1921 and the proportional representation for communities was made in the year 1927 in the State of Temil Nadu;

AND WHEREAS a large percentage of population of Tamil Nadu suffering from social and educational backwardness for many years have started enjoying the fruits of the reservation policy and have been able to improve their lot and attain a higher standard of living ;

AND WHEREAS clause (4) of Article 15 of the Constitution coables the State to make any special provision for the advancement of any socially and educationally Backward Classes of citizens or for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes ;

AND WHEREAS clause (4) of Article 16 of the Constitution enables the State to make any provision for the reservation of appointments or posts in favour of any Backward Class of citizens which, in the opinion of the State, is not adequately represented in the services under the State;

AND WHEREAS under clause (1) of Article 38 of the Constitution, the State shall strive to promote the welfare of the people by securing and protecting as effectively as it may, a social order in which justice, social, coonomic and political, shall inform all the pretitutions of the national life;

Notwithstanding anything contained in sections 4 and 5, the claims of the students or members belonging to the Backward Classes of citizens or the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, shall also be considered for the unreserved scals, appointments or posts which shall be filled on the basis of merit and where student or member belonging to the Backward Classes of citizens or the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, is selected on the basis of merit, the number of scales, approximizents or posts reserved for the Backward Classes of citizens or for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, as the case may be, shall not in any way he affected.

7. The Government may, from time to time, based on the reports presented at the appropriate periods to the Government by the Tamil Nadu Backward Classes Commission constituted in G.O. Ms. No. 9, Backward Classes and Most Evekward Classes Welfare Department, dated the 15th day of March 1993, by notification classify or sub-classify the Backward Classes of citizens for the purposes of this Act.

8. (1) The Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes of this ACL

(2) (a) All rules made under this Act shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gozette and unless they are expressed to come into force on a particular day, shall come into force on the day on which they are so published.

(b) All notifications issued under this Act shall, unless they are captered to come into force on a particular day, come into force on the day on which they are published.

(3) Every rule made or notification or order issued under this Act shall, as soon as possible, after it is made or issued, be placed on the table of the Legislative Assembly, and if, before the expiry of the session in which it is so placed or the next session, the Assembly makes any modification in any such rule or notification of order, or the Assembly decides that the rule or notification of order should not be made or issued, the rule or notification or order shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be, so, however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that rule or notification or order.

9. Notwithstanding anything contained in any judgment, decree or order of any court or other authority, the reservation of sixty-time per cent made, and anything done or any action taken on the basis of such reservation, by the Government for admissions into educational institutions in the State and for appointments or posts in the services under the State, for the Backward Classey of citizens and for the persons bolonging to the Scheduled Cartes and the Scheduled Tribes, during the period commencing on the 16th day of Nevember 1992 and

AND WHEREAS under clause (b) of Article 39 of the Constitution, the State shall, a particular, direct its policy towards securing that the ownership and control of the material resources of the community are so distributed as best to subserve the

AND WHEREAS under clause (c) of Article 39 of the Constitution, the State shall in particular, direct its policy towards securing that the operation of the economic system does not reach in the concentration of wealth and means of produc-

AND WHESEAS under Article 46 of the Constitution, the State shall promote, with special care, the educational and reconomic interests of the weaker sections of the

people, and, in particular, of the Scheduled Casses and the Scheduled Tribes, and shall protect them from source insistice and all forms of explositation;

AND WHEREAS the representatives of the various political parties and social forums representing backward classes have requested the State Government to consider all the ramifications of the Supreme Coart indement, dated the 16th day of November 1992 in *India Stationsy Vs. Union of India* (AIR, 1993 SC 477) regarding reservations under clause (d) of Article 16 of the Constitution and take steps to

AND WHEREAS in the opinion of the State Government, Backward Classes of cauzens, and the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, who constitute the majority of the total population of the State are not adequately represented in the services under the State in proportion to their population in the

AND WHEREAS the State Government have, after careful consideration, taken a policy decision that the existing level of sixty-nine per cent reservation in admission to educational institutions in the State and in the services under the State, for the Backward Classes of citizens and for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, should be communed for ensuring the advancement of the majority of the people of the State of Tamil Nadu :

Short utle, extent and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nidu Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of seats in Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the Services under the State) Act, 1993.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.

(3) (a) Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 16th day of November 1992.

12. It is hereby declared that this Act is for giving effect to the policy of the State towards securing the principles laid down in Part IV and in particular, in Article 38, clauses (b) and (c) of Article 39 and Article 46 of the Constitution.

Definitions

3. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,----

(a) "Backward Classes of citizens" means the class or classes of citizear who are socially and educationally backward, as may be notified by the Government in the Tantil Nadu Government Gazette, and includes the Most Backward Classes and the Denotified Communities ;

10. If any difficulty arises to giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the Sovernment may, by an order published in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gozette*, make such provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as appear to them to be necessary or capedient for reasoning the difficulty :

Power to remove difficulties.

(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any judgment, decree or order of any court or other authority, having regard to the inadequate representation in the services under the State, of the Backward Classes of citizens and the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, who constitute the majority of the total pepulation of the State of Tamil Nadu, the reservation for appointments or posts in the services under the State, for the Backward Classes of citizens and for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, shall be sixty-nine per cent.
