INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Candidates are not allowed in the Examination Hall without Hall-Ticket
2. The Candidates should write at least 20 lines in every page of their answer book.
3. The answers must be legibly written in blue or black ink
4. Special sketch pens or other pens should not be used for underlining points.
5. Candidates should not attempt to make any identification in the answer script. Marking the question number with special designs say circle, triangle or star markings are prohibited.
6. The candidates should write the correct register number in the space provided in the first page of the main answer book.
7. Candidates shall not write their register number in any part of their answer book or additional books, except on the space provided in the first page of the main answer book.
8. Electronic gadgets like Cellular phone, pager or other instruments for communication from outside will not be permitted inside the examination hall.

Candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination hall after 30 minutes of the commencement of the Examination. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall within the first 30 minutes of the duration of the examination time.

10. The candidates should personally handover the answer paper to the Hall-Superintendent before leaving the hall.

If the above instructions are not followed or any similar wrong is committed it will result in the invalidation of the answer book. Penal action will be taken by the University.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates should carefully fill in all the required details in the application form, including correct register number and correct subject codes failing which their application is liable to be rejected.
2. Candidates appearing for the first time should not fill the register number column. The University office will assign the register number. Others should fill up the register number assigned for the first year examination. **Candidates must enclose attested xerox copy of certificate in evidence of date of birth and qualifying examination passed while they apply first time for the University Examination.**
3. Candidates appearing for the first time should pay their fees for the whole (Semester) Examinations.
4. Blind Candidates are exempted from payment of Examination Fees. They should enclose copy of medical certificate for evidence. On the top of the application form, write as 'blind candidate'. However they should pay the fee for the statement of marks and application form.
5. The fee once paid will in no circumstance be refunded or held over for the subsequent examination.
6. The fees shall be remitted by Demand Draft drawn in favour of **The Registrar (A/c. DDE), Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University**, payable at **Chennai**.
7. All candidates appearing for the examination should forward their application through the Coordinator/Director, Department of Distance Education.
8. Candidates should obtain their hall tickets from the Coordinator/Director two days in advance of the commencement of examination, by producing relevant certificate of identity.
