# M.L./LL.M. [CBCS] Degree Examinations, August 2022

### **INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES**

Candidates are required to read the following Instructions carefully before filling the Exam Application Form

- M.L./LL.M. (CBCS) Degree Courses Semester Examinations, August 2022 will be conducted only through <u>OFFLINE</u> <u>MODE</u> and there is no change in the Question Paper Pattern of Examinations.
- 2. Examination Schedule and Time-Table is available in the University website and in the notice board of the Affiliated Law College.
- 3. The examinations of M.L./LL.M. (CBCS) Degree Courses are being conducted for the students as detailed below:
  - ➤ In respect of the students admitted for the academic year 2020-2021, the 4th (EVEN) Semester examinations along with their arrear examinations shall be conducted.
  - ➤ In respect of the students admitted for the academic year 2021-2022, the 1st (ODD) Semester examinations shall be conducted.
  - > All arrear examinations for the students who have completed the course shall be conducted.
- 4. Candidates shall apply for the examination only through **online mode by visiting the University website**: **www.tndalu.ac.in**, pay the required examination fee through online fees payment (in other fees column) and submit the exam application form.
- 5. Candidates are required to register for the papers according to their Branch, Batch and Regulation and also instructed to refer the Time-Table for registering the correct subject code.
- 6. For the online payment of Fees, candidates are required to follow the instructions given in the online payment form.
- 7. Candidates are required to upload a clear and visible recent passport size photo as the same will be printed in the Hall-Ticket & Attendance sheet.
- 8. Applications submitted through any other mode shall not be accepted.

- 9. Candidates are required to verify the details before submitting. No further corrections will be allowed.
- 10. **Visually Challenged Candidates:** Visually Challenged candidates are exempted from payment of examination fees. However they should pay the fees for Statement of marks and application cost.
- 11. The fees once paid, will in no circumstances be refunded or held over for the subsequent examinations.
- 12. Copy of the filled-in Exam Application form will be forwarded to candidate's registered Email-Id.
