Authors may kindly note the following guidelines in submitting the papers for publication :

1. Articles should be analytical, and products of original research or study. The maximum length of long articles and shorter comments or notes shall be 6000 and 2000 words respectively.
2. Authors should send one printout of manuscript typed in double space with at least 1 inch margin on both sides along with a soft copy in MS- Word.
3. Details about the author (name, designation, affiliation/s) is to be sent along with.
4. There shall be declaration from the authors to the effect, while submitting the article for consideration by the editorial board that the contribution in the product of research & does not form part of any article published earlier.
5. Submission shall conform to the citation system indicated below.
