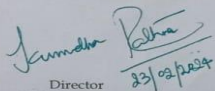

ABOUT THE PRO BONO ENVIRO MOOT COMPETITION:

The Moot Court Association [MCA] of the School of Excellence in Law, Chennai was established in the year 2008 with the view to promote oral advocacy skills and legal writing techniques. The foremost endeavour of the MCA is to develop and encourage mooting. Our flagship Competition, the Pro Bono Enviro National Moot Court Competition conducted annually since 2007 in collaboration with the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board, is the first Competition in the country to address environmental issues. This moot encourages students to expand their awareness of environmental concerns in the present world.

16TH PRO BONO ENVIRO MOOT COMPETITION: There were totally 55 teams from various universities and colleges participated, more than 150 students took part in this 16th pro bono enviro moot court competition. The problem for this year revolved around anthropogenic climate impact arising out of animal agriculture. The problem was about the state of Periyarnadu in Nationalisthan is rich in biodiversity and natural resources, with five perennial rivers and three major freshwater lakes. It also has six estuaries, serving as habitats for migratory birds and cetaceans. In 2018, the government announced a grant for setting up harbours in 10 states, including Periyarnadu. However, the establishment of a fishing harbour in the Ithuvumpocha estuary faced opposition from environmental groups and fisher welfare organizations due to potential harm. Construction began without proper clearances, leading to a significant public outcry. Renowned ornithologist Mr. Pakshi from Kochiko filed an application in the National Green Tribunal (NGT), arguing that the project violated laws, rendering the process redundant. The NGT admitted the application for a final hearing, considering factors such as ecological significance, the EIA Notification, and the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Notification, which prohibits the project due to the area's importance as a turtle nesting site and high erosion rates.

REPORT: The 16th Pro Bono Enviro National Moot Court Competition was conducted in hybrid mode. The researcher's test, rounds I and II of the preliminary rounds, the quarterfinals, and the semifinals all took place online. The Researcher's test was conducted on 27.01.2023. Considering the Covid-19 Pandemic the participants were made to attend the test in the format of that of a Google Form. They were asked questions regarding The Environment (Protection)

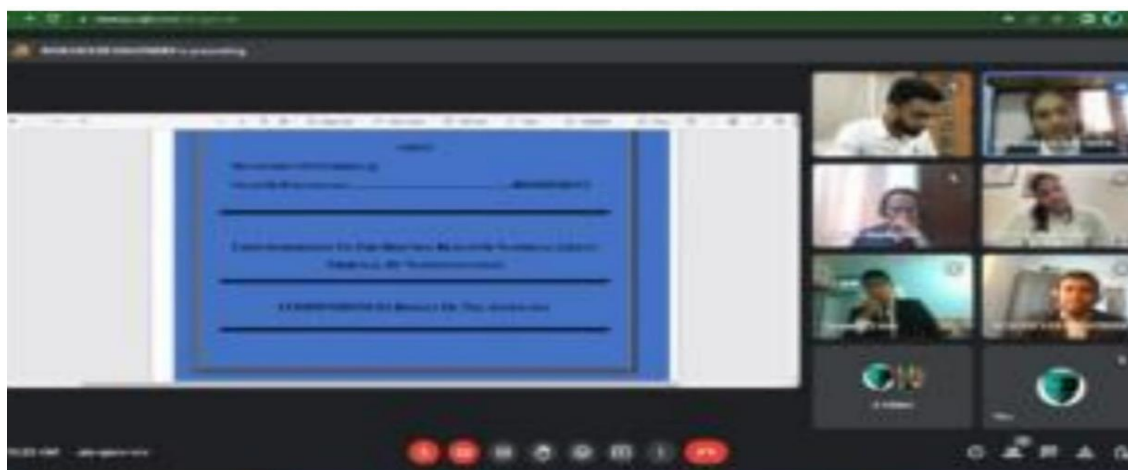
Act, the United Nations Conference on Human Environment, and so on. The Researcher's test proved to be comprehensive and challenging for all participants, and Mr. PrabhatSinghmar from Team Turkey was adjudged as the Best Researcher, with a praiseworthy 31/40 points. The Preliminary rounds I and II were conducted on 28.01.2023. The top 8 teams qualified to the Quarter-finals which was held on 29.01.2023. Team Quail from Sastra Deemed to be University, Team Kiwi from Institute of Law, Nirma University, Team Bluebird from Kerala University of Law and Team Nightingale from Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology were qualified to the Semi-finals which was conducted on 29.01.2023. The much awaited Final Rounds of 16th Pro Bono Enviro National Moot Court Competition, 2023 was conducted offline in the premises of the School of Excellence in law between the Team Quail from Sastra Deemed University as Petitioners and the Team Bluebird from Kerala University of Law as Respondents. The judges of the Finals are: Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.S. Ramesh being a former Additional Government Pleader for State of Tamil Nadu and has represented the government in various important cases. He was later elevated as a Hon'ble Judge of Madras High Court. The Second judge of this competition is Mr. SrinathSridevan who is one of the three founding partners of HSB Partners, a leading law firm in Chennai. He is also a member of the mining law committee of the International Bar Association, and has also made presentations before the parliamentary committee discussing the 2013 proposed amendments to the Mines and Minerals Development and Regulation Act. Thirdly, we had Mr. STS Murthy started his practice in Erode. He was appointed as the government pleader and further, as the Additional Advocate General and is Currently, one of the Senior Advocates of Madras HC. Finally, we had Mr. Yogeshwaran who has filed notable public interest litigations on environmental issues and sought remedy to a mass population. He has been closely associated with the bar and been a part of various awareness boots and camps. The Finals rounds had begun with the arrival of the Judges. The Valedictory ceremony begun with Prof. Dr. RajithOmmenAbrahan as Convener and the President of the MCA, SOEL Ms. Mansi Sethiya presented the Event Report. Lastly, the Results have been announced.

Ramamani, the Tamil Nadu DrAmbedkar Law University, School of Excellence in Law in association with S.A.P.R. Advocates has been conducting a national level taxation moot court competition for the past 12 years. The aim of this Moot Court Competition is to organize a high- quality event focused on taxation.

THE 13TH K.R. RAMAMANI MEMORIAL NATIONAL TAXATION MOOT COURT COMPETITION: The 13th K.R. Ramamani Memorial Taxation Moot Court Competition took place in the School of Excellence campus of the TNDALU in hybrid mode. BEST SPEAKER: The Best Speaker was adjudged to Speaker 1 of Team Rockwell, Anirud Narayan from Sastra deemed to be university.

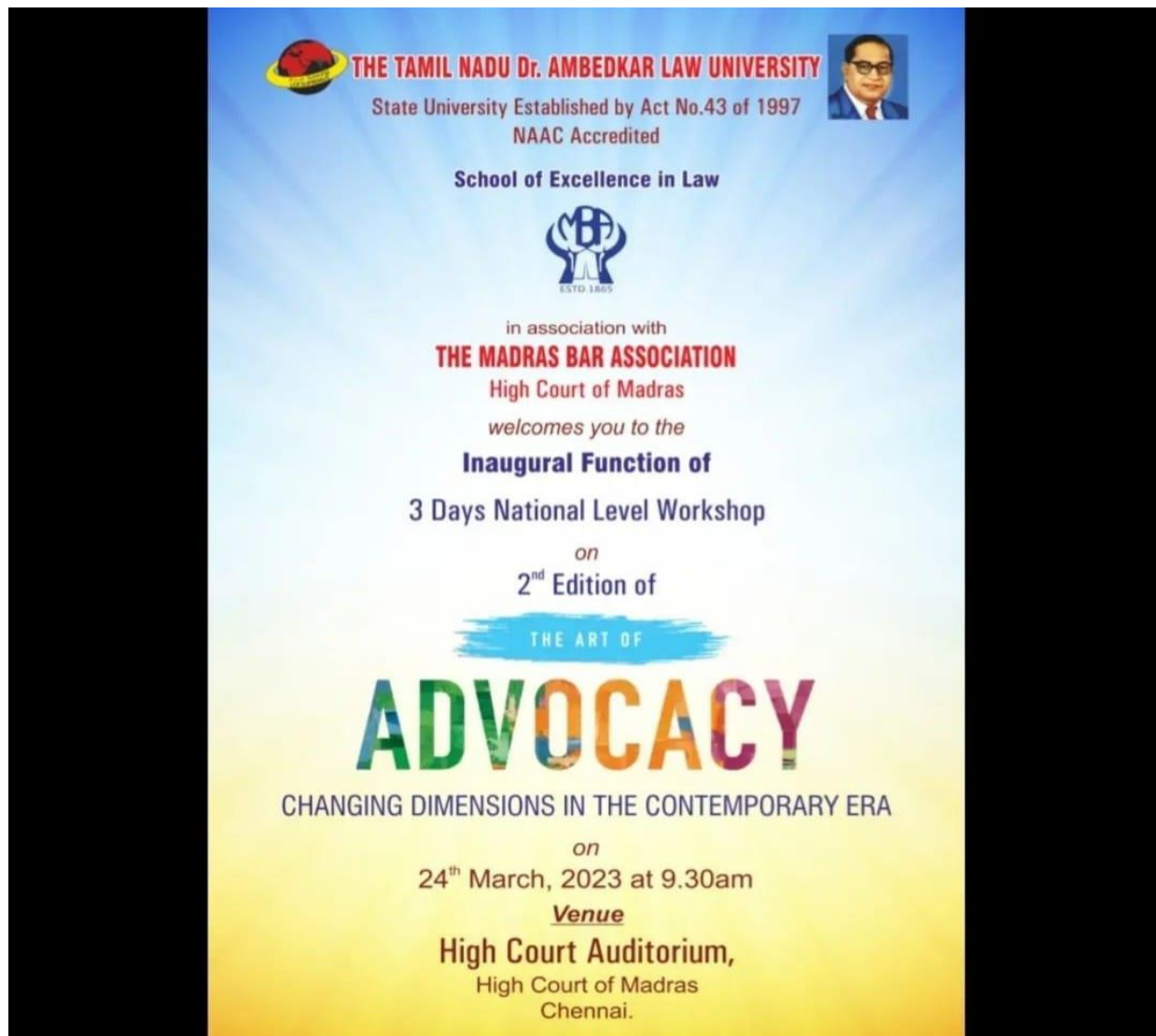
