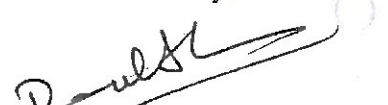

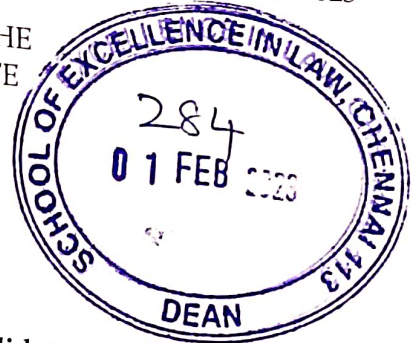

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the esteemed members of the Syndicate, including the new member Dr. J. Vijayalakshmi who is serving as Principal, Chennai Dr. Ambedkar Government Law College, Pattaraiperumpudur has been given full additional charge as Director of Legal Studies. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and the esteemed Members of the Syndicate congratulated Dr. J. Vijayalakshmi for her additional new assignment as the Director of Legal Studies incharge, State of Tamil Nadu.

Thiru. P.S. Amalraj, Chairman, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry raised the issue that as per Chapter IV, Sec. 24(1) of the TNDALU Act, 1996, the Syndicate shall meet at least once in every two months. The Vice-Chancellor replied that due to Covid-19 & Omicron disturbances, the University was unable to get the convenient date of the members to conduct the meeting. 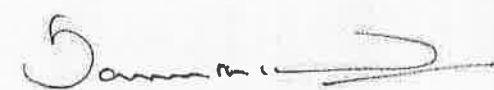

At the outset, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor introduced himself to the Academic Senate, as he himself being the new member to the Academic Senate after assuming the Office of the Vice-Chancellor on 09.04.2021 and extended his warm greetings to the new members of the Syndicate and the Academic Senate.

Before discussing the agenda, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor briefed the following activities of the University to the Members of the Academic Senate:-

1. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu in the presence of the Hon'ble Minister for Law, Courts & Prisons and Prevention of Corruption and the Pro-Chancellor of the University inaugurated through Video Conferencing on 06.09.2021, the additional U.G. Block constructed out of the University fund at Perungudi Campus at a cost of Rs. 13 crores consisting of 18 smart class rooms, with wi-fi internet facilities.
2. A Team of five students from the School of Excellence in Law topped the charts in the prestigious Philip C Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition - India and Asia Regional Rounds, 2021 held in the month of February 2021. This is for the first time in the History of the University a Team has been ranked among the Top 48 teams in the world.
3. A team of students of the School of Excellence in Law, The Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University have been awarded "The Best Prosecution Memorandum" in the Nuremberg Moot Court Competition. Our students competed with 112 teams from around the world and won this award. Last year also our students took part in the same competition and won "Second Best Memorandum Defence Award".
4. A Model United Nations 2021 Edition was organized on 1st and 2nd May, 2021 through online mode, which is rarest in nature. Around 100 teams from various institutions registered for participation, unfortunately the team from 80 institutions have taken part in the competitions and the team from VIT University won the Best Delegation Award.
5. One of the final year students of the 5 year Integrated (Hons.) Degree Course Mr. Sachin Raj authored a Book "Indian Film Law" and it was released at the hands of Hon'ble Justice Bharathidasan, Judge, High Court of Madras on 12th July, 2021 at the Poompozhi Campus of the University.
6. The University conducted the 14th Pro Bono Enviro National Moot Court Competition, 2021 from 18.02.2021 to 22.02.2021. The University organized 11th Edition of K.R. Ramamani Memorial National Taxation Moot Court Competition between 05.03.2021 and 07.03.2021 through virtual mode.

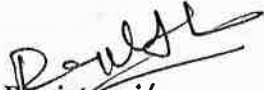
