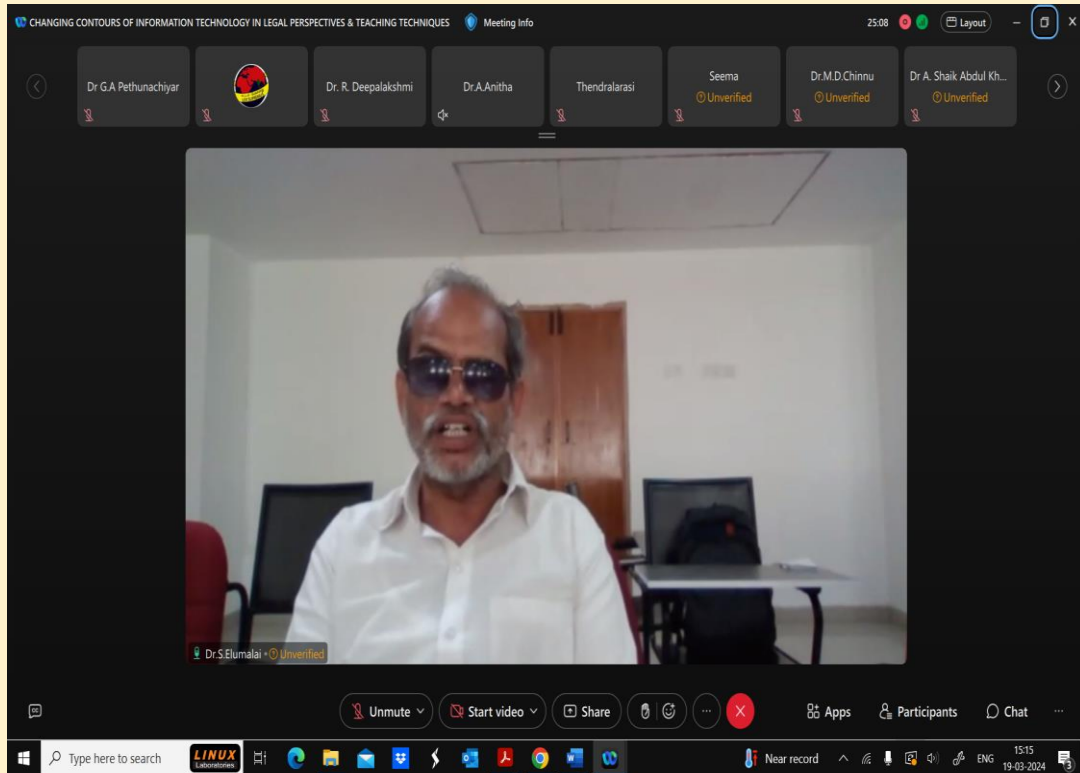




## DAY 2 19/03/2024

Day 2 resource person was **Dr. S. Elumalai**, specialized in International Law and Constitutional Law and also serves as the Head i/c, Department of human rights and duties education. He has authored more than 10 books, published around 25 articles, and presented more than 50 papers at international and national conferences. He is a recipient of several national, state and corporate awards, the notable ones are the National award for meritorious service with disability from the President of India (2020) and Best Law Teacher by the Government of Tamil Nadu (2012). He also serves as an EC member in several departments such as ABS-NBA, ABS-QCI, MOEFCC, and Government of India. He has served as an Expert Consultant of the UNDP for implementing the ABS Mechanism in India (Nagoya Protocol). His area of interest includes IPR, Constitutional law, International Trade law, Taxation law, and environmental law.



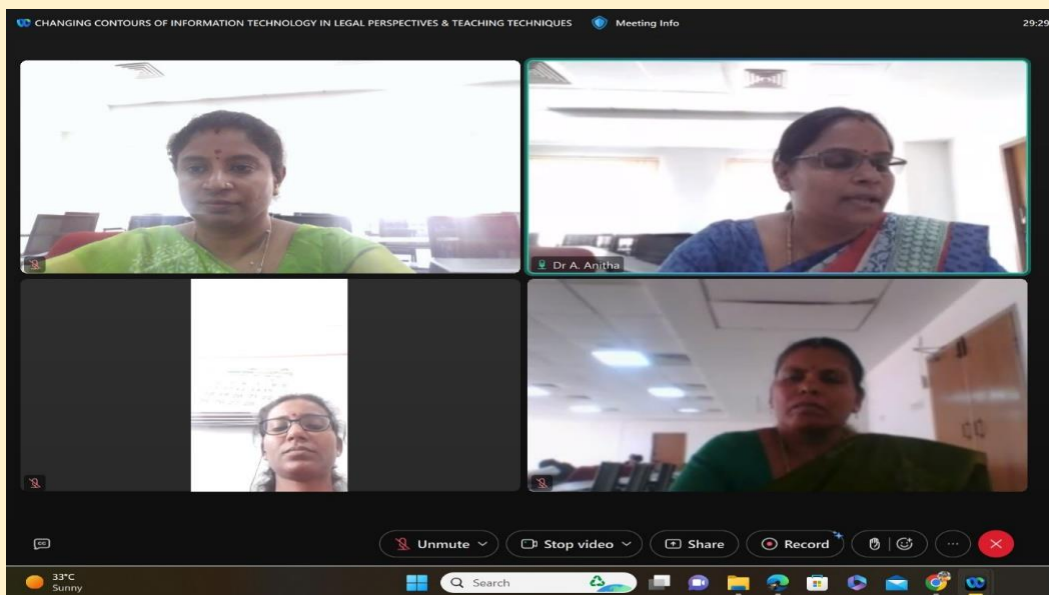
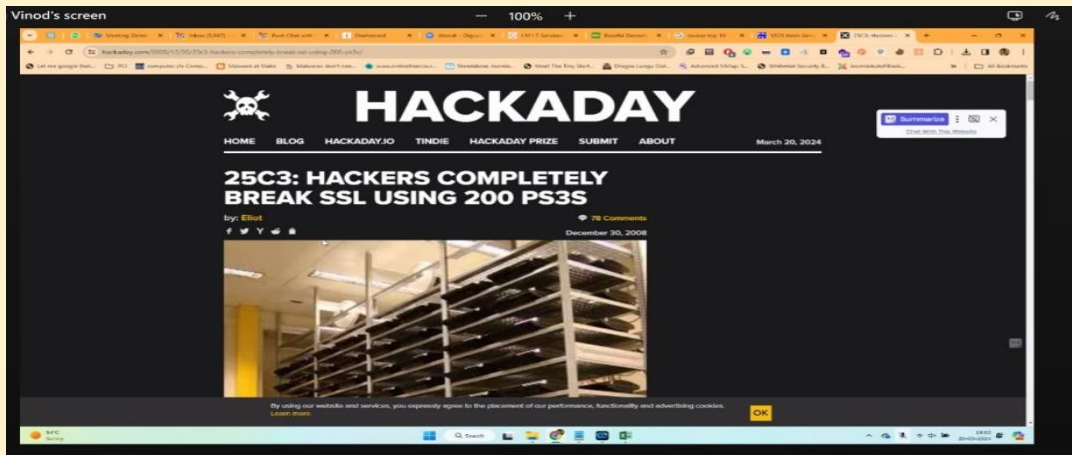


### Dr. Elumalai explaining Evolution of Legal AI Jurisprudence in India

The resource person has covered a wider topic of Jurisprudence in India which marks a transformative journey in the landscape of law and technology. His speech includes the rapid advancements in artificial intelligence (AI) and its integration into legal systems and how India has witnessed a paradigm shift in legal services. Initially, legal AI tools were employed for tasks such as contract review, due diligence, and legal research, enhancing efficiency and accuracy in legal processes. However, as the technology matured, its applications expanded to predictive analytics, case outcome predictions, and even virtual legal assistants. This evolution has not only streamlined legal procedures but has also improved access to justice by providing cost-effective solutions and bridging the gap between legal expertise and the common citizen. Moreover, the emergence of AI-driven platforms has facilitated legal education and awareness, empowering individuals with knowledge of their rights and obligations. Despite challenges such as data privacy, ethical concerns, and the need for regulatory frameworks, the evolution of Legal AI Jurisprudence in India reflects a promising synergy between law and technology, poised to redefine the future of legal practice and adjudication in the nation.

Resource Person **Vinod** is a certified cybersecurity professional and the CEO of infySEC, an accomplished cyber security firm. Vinod started out as a teenager who wanted to hack into systems to detect their vulnerabilities. As a young boy in the early 2000s, he simply could not fathom the fact that security on the internet was limited. The cyber space had just begun to take shape and was already under a lot of stress. He knew right then that his purpose in life was to build a safe and secure online environment for those of the present and the future. But he also knew all too well that he could not do it alone, and that's why he started building an army, one that could walk alongside him, one that shared in his burning passion, and long-lasting dreams. infySEC was born out of the efforts to create this army.

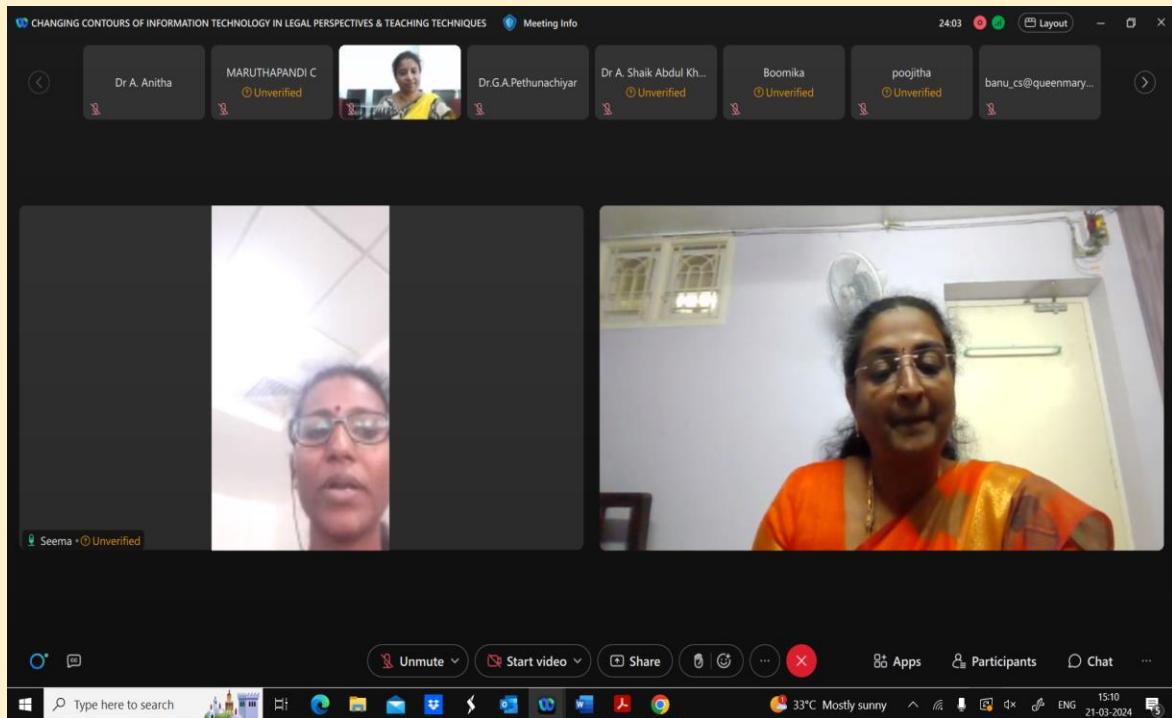

Sir has elaborately explained topics like 25C3. The session was more interactive and participants clarified their doubts at end of the session.

**DAY 4**  
**21/03/2024**

**Dr. B. Lavanya** working as an Associate Professor in University of Madras with Specialization as Data Science, Data Mining, Bioinformatics. She has got 8 best paper awards and 14 academic awards. She has completed 6 projects to her credit. She has published 9 books in her subject and got 4 Patents in her credit. She has published around 50 articles in reputed journals. She has given more than 30 invited talks in various colleges and Universities.



The faculty development program on 21st March of 2024 started off with an introductory speech by our faculty Miss.Seema who gave a brief introduction about the resource person Dr.Lavanya B who specialised in data analytics. She discussed the topic "Gen AI tools for teaching and research". She started the session by mentioning the existence of generative AI for the past two decades. She also explained about the hierarchy of generative AI to the artificial intelligence tools. She discussed the history of AI tools and gave us examples on how Gen AI works. She stated that the main aim was to make General AI understand and respond in human

language. She also discussed the following topics like practical use of Gen AI and Its different types, application landscape of Gen AI and how people use it. Then she gave us insights about inclusive teaching and learning using AI and discussed cases of using AI in teaching. Later on, she enlightened us about various challenges of using Gen AI in education. Finally she showed us 30 AI tools to use in the classrooms, their platforms and pricing. Later she also gave us information on using Gen AI tools in research. She concluded her teaching by showing a demo on how to use few Gen AI tools like slidesgo and quillbot. Finally she insisted on checking for validation of data provided by the AI and shared her personal experience on using AI for research purposes.

Our resource person Lavanya mam also encouraged all the faculty members to become AI enabled knowledge workers.

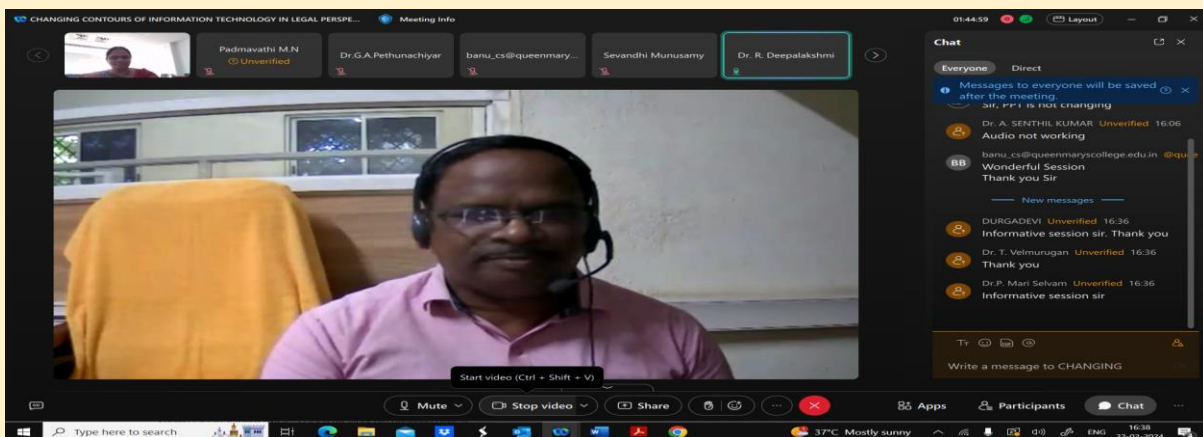

He has guided more than 300 M.Phil., Research Scholars. To add feather on his accomplishment, So far, 24 Scholars have been awarded doctorates degree under his guidance and supervision, and presently 6 Scholars are pursuing Ph.D Degree. He has published more than 200 articles in SCOPUS, SCI indexed and WOS journals. He was elected and served as a Senate Member from Academic Council, University of Madras. He has a lot of administrative experiences, To mention a few, he has been the Head of the Department for the Department of Computer Science, Department of BCA in D. G. Vaishnav College, selection committee Member for Qualification approval in University of Madras, Expert Committee Member for course affiliation and many more. The fourth day of the FDP meeting started off by the introduction of our resource person Dr.T Velmurugan sir who discussed the topic “Maximizing the research identity and Impact using the H index”. He stated that Research and Publication is the base of Higher Education. His teaching included the definition of research and research methodology, Technical definitions of researches and the motivations in research. He then briefed about Quantitative and Qualitative Research Approaches and types of research. He also explained to us about the steps in the research process by telling us how to start a research and gave us tips on technical writings. He also told us about the difference between Thesis and Research Articles by explaining about the IMRaD format of the two. Then he told us about how the organisation of a scientific paper is done by briefing the contents of it showing us the materials and methodologies. He showed us how to write literature surveys using references and manage them. Then he finally explained the key points to a manuscript and indexing services by telling us about the journal impact factor and other journals with links. He was very welcoming with questions from all the faculties of the session.

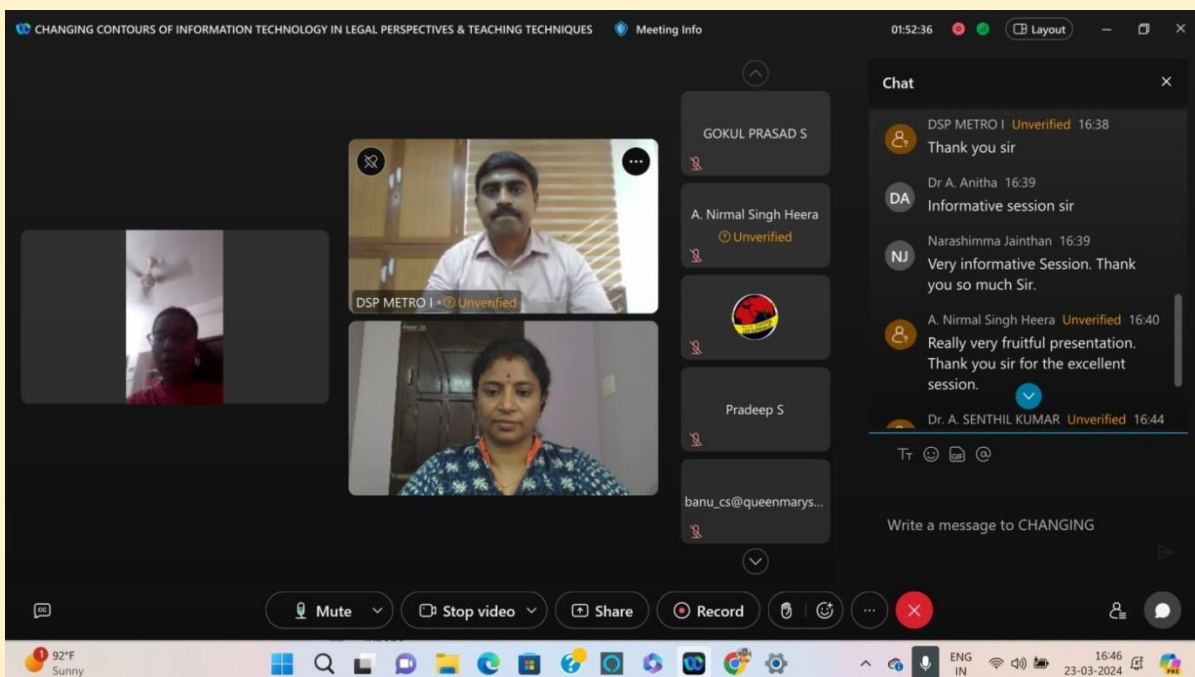

His teaching included topics about cyber offences such as Morphing, Fake Social Media profiles, cyber stalking, cyber bullying, online trolling, identity theft, phishing, camera hacking and etc. He shared his personal experiences on various cases about cybersecurity and how he handled them.







He also explained about the safety measures to be taken by every individual in order to safeguard themselves from cyber offences. He Majorly stated the don'ts to be followed while in the cyberspace. He insisted on never keeping things to ourselves and to reach out for help through the official website and 1930 which is a very crucial emergency contact in recent times and has been very effective in helping many people. He cleared the doubts of faculties about mobile theft and what immediate precautionary measures to be taken. He also explained about the job scams that have been used to fraud many people into scams. He also mentioned about how young children find it difficult to come out about these offences and sometimes it leads to suicides which can be reduced by proper guidance on how to reach out. He also assured that the department of cybersecurity will do every measure they can to provide us with proper guidance and help.
