REPORT OF THE EVENT:

The Department of Environmental law and legal order of The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University organised a special lecture on topic "Writing the environmental history of India in the age of Anthropocene" on 15th March, 2024.

The programme started by the welcome address delivered by Asst. Prof. Dr. V. Gajendran (Sociology) and it was followed by felicitation of the guest by Prof. Dr. P. Sakthivel, Associate Professor, Director of LL.B (Hons), TNDALU.

Then the Chief guest Mr. Aditya Ramesh, Assistant Professor, Department of History, University of Manchester started the lecture. The eminent speaker who has the knowledge with regard to the environmental history of India started his lecture with the term Anthropocene. Then he stated about the Shift in the Earth system and the four critical framewoks. He added about the difference between the Limits to growth and growth within limit and another differentiation about Social emission and Luxury Emission. Further he stated about the Environmental history of India and the problems in our history. He also addressed about the Global warming, Climate injustice and Climate colonialism. Then his lectuare gave some insights on Chipko movement, Kyoto protocol and the colonioal watershed thesis. He shared about some books named "Ecological Nationalism", "China go green", "The unquiet woods" and "Big world small planet" for our further reference. And he concluded with three ideas, firstly, Go back to the past, secondly, focus on the Environmental policy making and thirdly, Global network of Knowledge. The power point presentation helped the students to keep a track on the lecture and it helped in a great way for the students to be both interactive and attentive. Around 50 students from post graduate have attended the session. The expert clarified many questions posted by the students and he answered all the queries raised by the participants.

After completion of question and hour session, Prof. Dr. R. Haritha Devi, HOD, Department of Environmental Law and Legal order, TNDALU conveyed the vote of thanks.
