CONDUCTION OF EVENT:

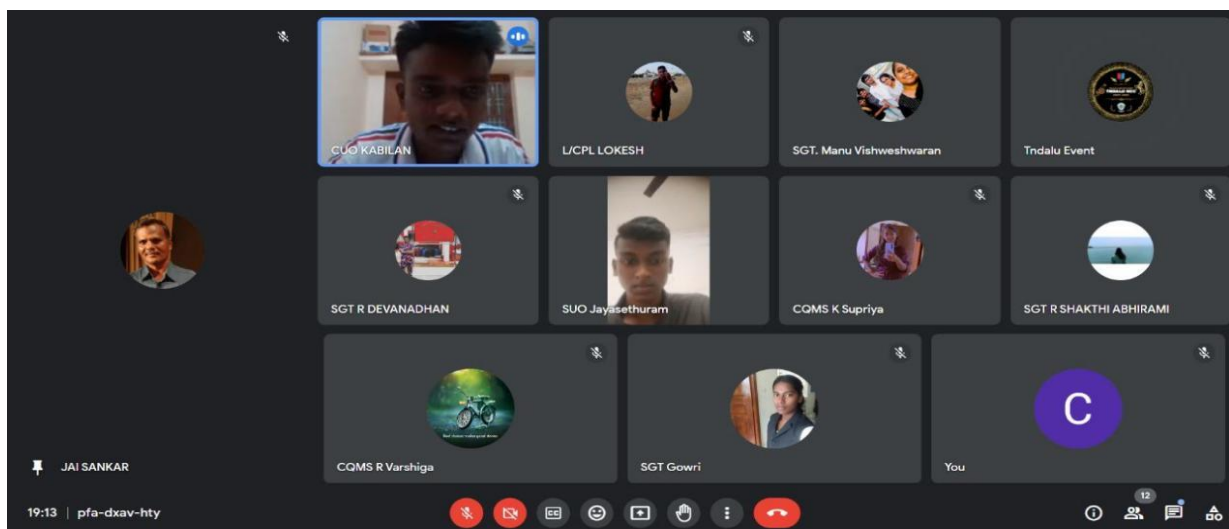

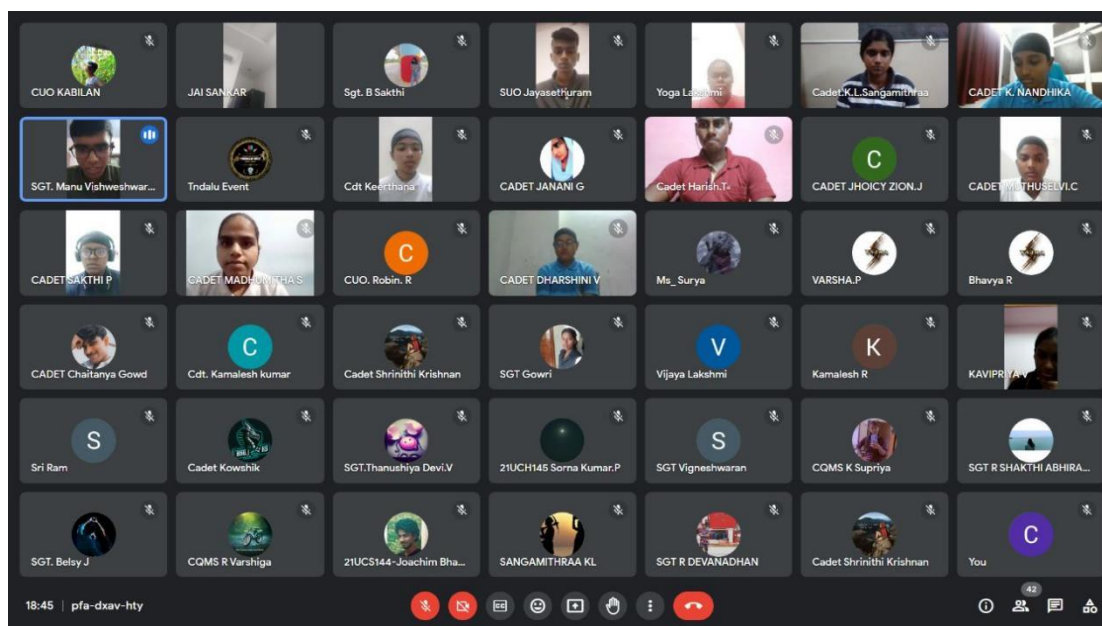
The gathering was welcomed by SUO Jayasethuram. K. The cadets of Tamil Nadu Dr. Law University presented speeches.

Following the investiture the quiz competition commenced. Around 100 cadets from various colleges participated in this quiz competition actively.

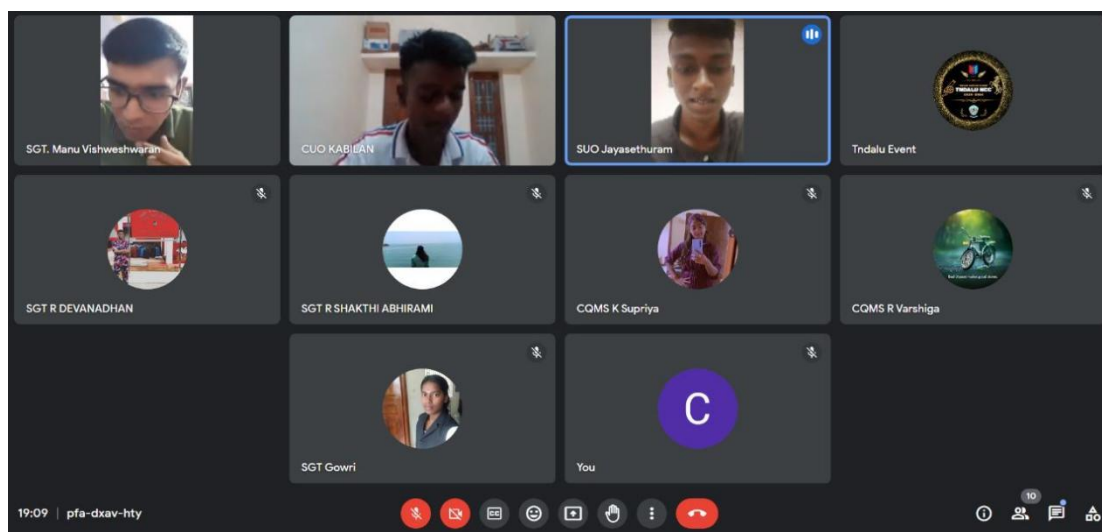
The event gave a big impact among the cadets of various groups and directorates about importance, issues, causes etc., about the environment.

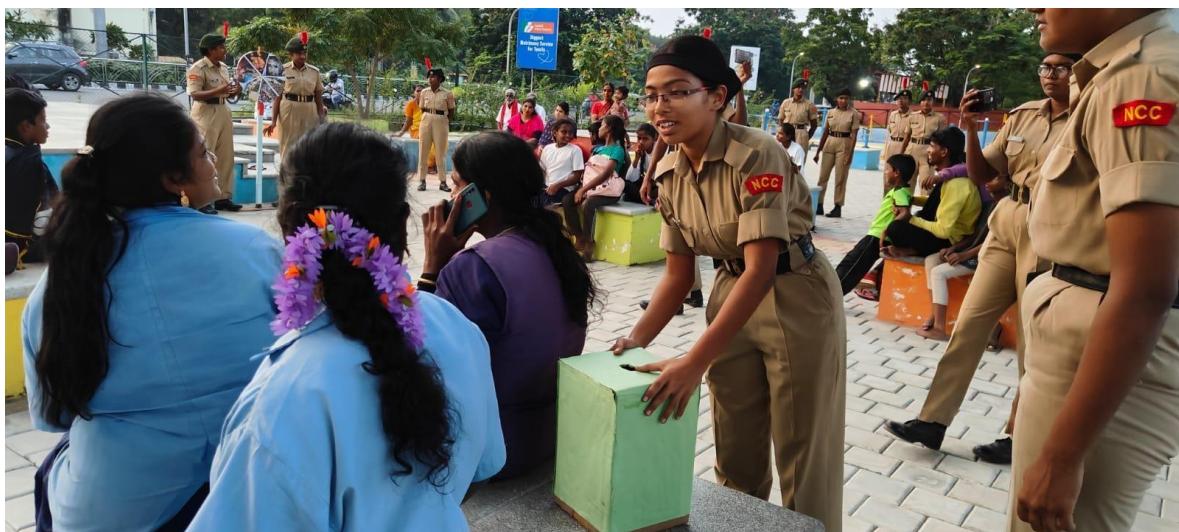

Prior Permission was also received from Police Department, for conducting this Public awareness program. **Taramani Traffic police**

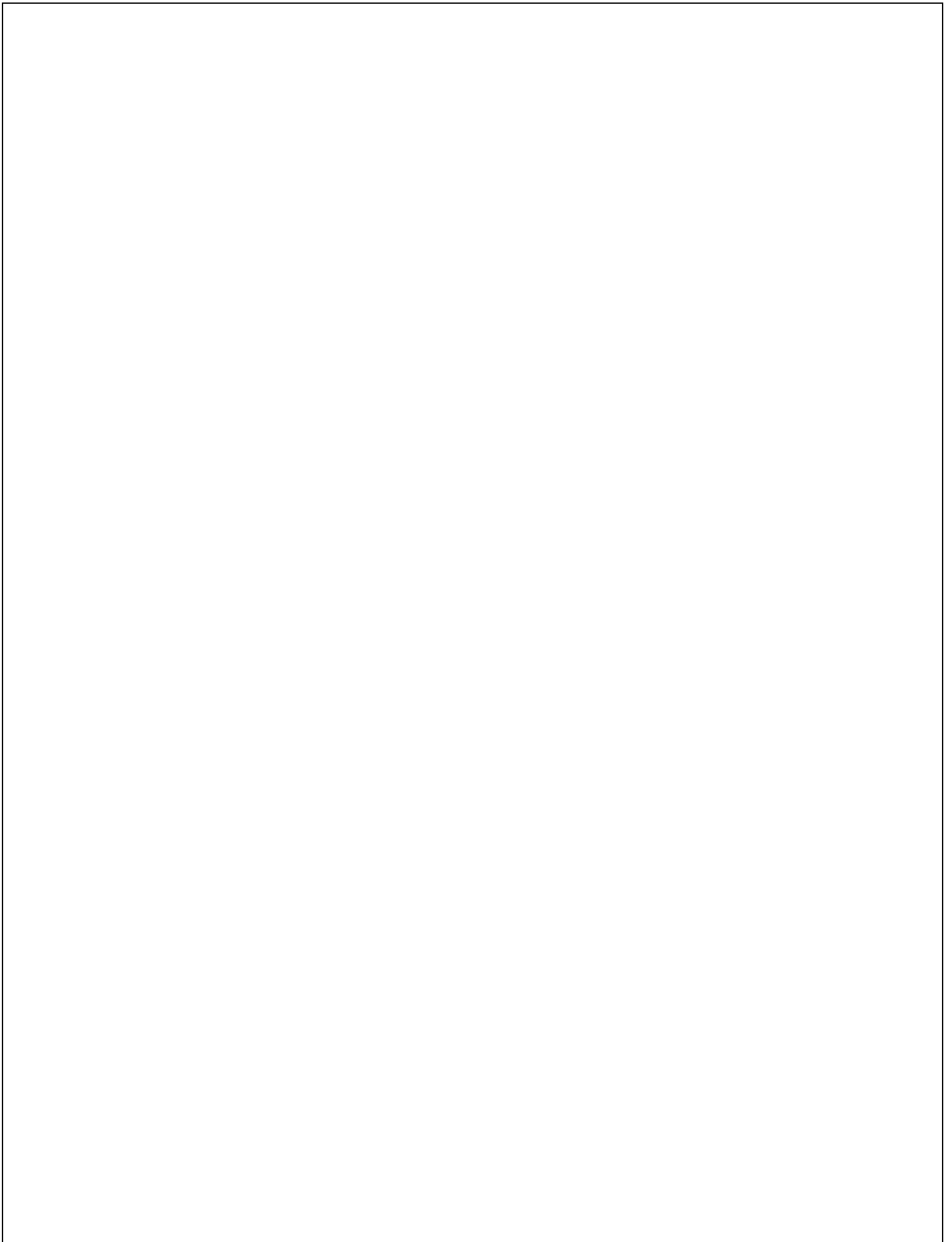
team, also supported us in conducting this program smoothly and safely.
