Gavai, Executive Chairman, NALSA, is organizing the Pan-India Zonal Reel Making & Short Film Competition for Law Students, titled "Connecting with the Cause."

About the Competition:

This competition is aimed at promoting legal awareness through modern media tools by encouraging law students across India to create engaging reels and short films on NALSA schemes and related topics. The topics will include the following:

Submission Guidelines:

- The competition is open to all students of SOEL pursuing the 5-Year and 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) Degree Programmes.
- Students must submit their Reel/Short Film to the Legal Aid Clinic, SOEL on or before 11th February 2025 by 23:59 Hours.
- Submissions must align with one of the prescribed topics and creatively highlight the importance of legal awareness and access to justice.
- All entries must be original and must not infringe upon any copyright or third-party rights.

Awards & Recognition:

NALSA will evaluate all zonal submissions and select winners and runners-up in each category from the four zones.

- Winner: ₹10,000/-
- Runner-Up: ₹5,000/-

The winners and runners-up will be felicitated by esteemed dignitaries.
