CIRCULAR

Sub: The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University- School of Excellence in Law-
Academic Year 2026-2027-Notification in relation to the Constitution of the Moot Court
Association for the Academic Year 2026-2027- Intimated- Reg.

It is hereby informed that the Moot Court Association, School of Excellence in Law (hereinafter referred to as the "MCA") is to be constituted shortly for the Academic Year 2026-27. The MCA is therefore inviting Office Bearers and Members from among bona fide law students enrolled in the three-year or five-year LL.B.(HONS.) degree courses at the School of Excellence in Law. Interested students are invited to apply for membership by submitting an application along with the necessary details outlined in this notification.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Eligibility criteria for the Office Bearers and Members are mentioned hereinafter:

To Note:

1. One position in the MCA Core Committee shall be reserved for a member from the 3-Year LL.B. programme.
2. Notwithstanding the above clause 3- Year LL.B. programme students can also compete for MCA core position in unreserved seats based on point system.



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3. Only students who have served as a Member of the Moot Court Association for at least one academic year shall be eligible to hold positions in the MCA Core Committee.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA:

2.1. The MCA strictly adheres to the system of **“POINTS OF MERIT”** to determine the students for the aforementioned positions.

2.2. Every applicant's performance academically would also play a pivotal role in the selection process.

2.3. If a particular student was a part of the MCA in any of the preceding years, their previous performances / contributions to the committee would also be taken into account.

The calculation of points is based on the below mentioned scheme:

3. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION:

Interested students must submit the following documents through e-mail:

3.1. An APPLICATION LETTER specifying the post for which the application is being submitted.

3.2. A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE elaborating the intent behind applying to such post.

3.3. A FILLED APPLICATION CUM DECLARATION FORM in the format to be provided in the MCA website.

3.4. CURRICULUM VITAE/RESUME containing:

3.4.1. List of all relevant competitions participated in and the result of such participation.

3.4.2. Previous MCA Membership (if any); and

3.4.3. Copy of all relevant certificates for all the relevant competitions listed in 3.4.1. Only certificates from organizing committee will be accepted, any other format will not be accepted.

3.4.4. In case of applying for the post of a Photographer, a digital portfolio of 5 photographs (in PNG format) demonstrating skill in various settings and styles must be attached, along with a draft Instagram story (in PNG Format).

3.5. The E-Mail's subject shall indicate “<POST NAME>- APPLICATION FOR THE MCA 2026-2027.”

3.6. The e-mail in the prescribed format must be sent to facultymcasoel2026@gmail.com on or before 1st of July 2026 (Wednesday) by 23:59 Hours.



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3.7. Applications sent to any other e-mail ID or beyond the prescribed time frame shall not be considered.

4. CLARIFICATIONS / DISQUALIFICATIONS:

The following clarifications and disqualifications will be strictly considered and interpreted at the time of evaluation of every individual Application and thereafter:

4.1. Students who are already holding or are anticipating to hold any **OFFICE BEARER** post in any **OTHER COMMITTEE(S) OF SOEL** are strictly **INELIGIBLE** to apply for office bearers in MCA. Such applications, if received, would be rejected.

4.2. If the selected student gets the opportunity to hold any such posts after being selected for MCA 2026-27, he/she has to mandatorily elect either of the committees and notify Faculty Coordinator of the MCA regarding their decision within a week.

4.3. The Competitions organized by the Universities, Institutes, reputed Law Firms, and Bar Associations, either individually or collectively by any one or more of them, alone shall be considered for the purpose of evaluation.

4.4. Participation / wins in such competitions which were duly notified in the MCA website would be **ALONE** be taken into consideration. Competitions which the student had participated in his private capacity would not be considered.

4.5. In cases of tie in the points between two students who have applied for the same post, the **RESULTS OF SEMI-FINALS** of the competitions organized by the entities enumerated above, or Academic Performance could be considered.

4.6. Each applicant who submits photographic content (hereinafter referred to as “the Content”) through the application process must warrant that the Content is an original work captured by the applicant and does not infringe upon the intellectual property rights of any third party.

4.7. The submission of the Content by the applicant constitutes a declaration that the Content is not plagiarized, copied, or appropriated from any other individual's or entity's work without authorization. Any Content found to be in violation of this provision will result in immediate disqualification from the application process.



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4.8. If there exist any disparities in the selection process / results, the **DECISION** of the **FACULTY CO-ORDINATOR** shall be **FINAL**.

4.9. Students who, upon induction into MCA, fail to diligently perform the duties and obligations that their position entails will be disqualified from the Committee subject to the discretion of the faculty coordinator.
